MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED:

15. Site Inspection Report –Briarwood Public School (Ward 4)

Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on June 1, 2010 to review the warrants for a crossing guard at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road & Central Parkway.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. That should school bus service be removed in September 2010 for students attending Briarwood Public School, 1065 Mississauga Valley Boulevard, living north of Burnhamthorpe Road, that two (2) Crossing Guards be implemented at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Central Parkway.
2. That the Site Inspection Subcommittee of Traffic Safety Council be requested to review the warrants for the Crossing Guards at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Central Parkway during the second and fourth weeks of September 2010, and during the third week of October 2010, to determine if the warrants for the Crossing Guards are still being met.
3. That the Principal of Briarwood Public School be notified that the subject Crossing Guards are being placed at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Central Parkway on a trial basis, and that should the warrants for the Crossing Guards fail to be met at the site inspections conducted in Fall 2010, that Traffic Safety Council may recommend that the crossing guards be removed;

And further, that the Principal be requested to notify parents of the decision of Traffic Safety Council in a manner that he deems appropriate.

16. Site Inspection Report- Oscar Peterson Public School (Ward 10)

Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on June 15, 2010 to review pedestrian safety concerns at the intersection of Tenth Line West & Perennial Drive.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. That the Principal of Oscar Peterson Public School, 5120 Perennial Drive, be requested to initiate a Dismissal Program beginning in September 2010.
2. That the Peel District School Board be requested to extend the fence along Tenth Line adjacent to the east side of the property at Oscar Peterson Public School, removing the opening and restricting access to the building from Tenth Line.
3. That the Site Inspection Subcommittee of Traffic Safety Council conduct a follow-up site inspection at Oscar Peterson Public School once recommendation 1 and 2 have been completed.
4. That members of Traffic Safety Council meet onsite with staff from Oscar Peterson Public School and the Peel District School Board to consider driveway modifications which could better accommodate vehicular traffic on and adjacent to the school property.

Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on June 22, 2010 to review pedestrian safety on South Service Road at Queen Elizabeth Senior Public School.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. That Transportation & Works be requested to review the School Zone signage at Queen Elizabeth Senior Public School, 60 South Service Road.
2. That the Principal of Queen Elizabeth Senior Public School be requested to review proper crossing procedures with students.
3. That the Ministry of Transportation be requested to relocate the sidewalk from the tunnel under the QEW to South Service Road, to line-up with east side of the east school driveway exit to improve sight lines for crossing pedestrians and to avoid traffic traveling eastbound on South Service Road, exiting the school property westbound.
4. That the Peel District School Board be requested to construct a sidewalk along the eastside of the east driveway exit to provide student access to the school, once the walkway has been relocated.
5. That the Site Inspection Subcommittee of Traffic Safety Council re-inspect South Service Road at Queen Elizabeth Senior Public School in September 2010.

Recommendation:

 - a. Install “Drop-Off Area” signs above the “No U-Turn” signs that already exist along the north side of the driveway;
 - b. Install two “Student Crossing” signs on the north and south sides of the driveway, in front of the brick crosswalk that leads to the front entrance of the school
2. That the Peel District School Board be requested to repaint the lines on the driveway and add lines to demarcate two crosswalks, one on each end of the driveway, where curb cuts already exist.

3. That the Peel District School Board be requested to install bicycle racks at a suitable location on the property of John Fraser Secondary School.
4. Following the implementation of recommendation 3, that the Principal be requested to encourage parents to have their children walk or cycle to school, to reduce the volume of vehicular traffic on or near the school property.
