4. <u>Capital Projects Update</u>

Memorandum dated August 31, 2010 from Annemarie Hagan, Museums Manager, presenting an update on Capital Projects at the Museums of Mississauga, including the Leslie Log House, the Summer Kitchen, the Benares DVD, as well as Facility and Property Management projects at Benares Historic House and Bradley Museum.

Annemarie Hagan, Museums Manager presented an update on the Capital Projects as at the end of August 2010. She discussed budget and schedule challenges faced by the Leslie Log House project. The City is in the process of working out site services issues with the Region of Peel. An official opening of the Leslie Log House is scheduled for Saturday, May 14, 2011.

Councillor Pat Mullin informed that various infrastructure stimulus projects are currently under way in the City.

Annemarie Hagan, Museums Manager distributed complimentary copies of the Discover Benares Historic House DVD to members of the Museums of Mississauga Advisory Committee. Complimentary copies of the DVD will also be distributed to Friends of The Museums of Mississauga Board members at their September meeting. 5. <u>Museums Manager's Report</u>

Memorandum dated August 31, 2010 from Annemarie Hagan, Museums Manager, presenting the Museums Manager's Report for the period June 1, 2010 to August 31, 2010.

Annemarie Hagan, Museums Manager presented her report for the period June to August 2010. She updated the members on the various special events conducted at the Museums of Mississauga during the period. 340 people attended the Driftwood Theatre's "Twelfth Night" at the Bradley Museum and over 600 people attended the 16th Annual Teddy Bears Picnic at the Benares Historic House, which received a \$1,000 sponsorship by Holcim.

Annemarie informed that the 150 people attended the 90th birthday celebrations of Barbara Larson, one of the original donors of Benares, despite the inclement weather condition on that night. She informed of upcoming community events will include Doors Open Mississauga to be held on September 18, 2010, coinciding with the Mississauga Fall Festival, at the Bradley Museum.

There has been a slight decrease in participants at the Hands on History Day Camp. Other camps, run by the Clarkson Community Centre staff at the Museums included Benares

Blaster and Discovery Camp. Participation at the monthly Traditional Afternoon Tea at Bradley Museum is very encouraging.

Copies of the new Culture Division branding designed by the City's Communications Division were distributed to members of the Committee.
