Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on November 15, 2010 to review the warrants for a Crossing Guard.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. That the request for a crossing guard at the intersection of Molly Avenue and Burnhamthorpe Road for the students attending Briarwood Public School, 1065 Mississauga Valley Boulevard be denied as the warrants have not been met as the traffic signals provide protection for crossing students.
2. That Transportation & Works be requested to ensure that the traffic control signal at the intersection of Molly Avenue and Burnhamthorpe Road is set to a slow walking speed for students crossing Burnhamthorpe Road.
