Mississauga: Canada's Global Investment Destination

As we enter the second year of implementing the City's 10-year Economic Development Strategy, Mississauga is one step closer to becoming a *Global Business Magnet*.

To guide the Economic Development Office in achieving this goal, Council received a new international marketing strategy entitled, "Mississauga - Canada's Global Investment Destination: An International Marketing Strategy". The report presents a theme for the City to embrace in its international marketing efforts.

After extensive analysis of Mississauga's foreign direct investment (FDI) potential, the following key international marketing opportunities emerged from the new marketing strategy: to use Mississauga's local multicultural population to leverage connections; to encourage the development of entrepreneurial ventures that use

international connections; to leverage Mississauga's "local" multi-national businesses to become champions and recruit other divisions within their corporate structure and supply chains; to target fast growing economies such as Brazil, Russia, India and China (BRIC Nations) who are becoming increasingly important drivers of FDI; and lastly, to leverage Mississauga's location as an international multimodal hub and a driver of goods and passenger movement in and out of Canada.

Given these new opportunities, an international marketing action plan has been developed and will be reviewed and implemented over the next five years. The International Marketing Strategy will help guide the EDO's strategic initiatives and actions and supports the goal for Mississauga to become a Global Business Magnet.

Enrolment increases for second semester

Sheridan College's Hazel McCallion Campus located in downtown Mississauga is now in its second semester accommodating 1,760 students, including 1,200 business students since opening in September 2011. The campus is a 155,000 sq.ft. facility, boasting 33 leading edge classrooms and learning spaces, including the collaboratory, a room that allows faculty to explore the integration of new technologies in the teaching process. The Mississauga campus specializes in an array of post-secondary and post-graduate business programs, as well as services and programs designed to help newcomers integrate into the local economy.

Council adopts the Living Green Master Plan, shifting attention to living greener in Mississauga

Setting the path toward environmental sustainability, Mississauga can do so with the confidence of having a reliable roadmap in hand. City Council approved the Mississauga Living Green Master Plan (LGMP) earlier this year, and implementation of the plan has begun.

The LGMP is an action oriented document. There are 49 actions outlined, under the headings of actions to set an example and encourage and compel others. It was developed through a collaborative process that included public consultation with a variety of stakeholders representing businesses, residents, civic leaders and city staff.

This spring a marketing campaign will be launched to mobilize the community into action. According to Brenda Osborne, Manager of Environment, "There's no better time for action. We recognize that environmental sustainability, economic prosperity and quality of life are related features of the most successful communities. By making sustainable living a Mississauga priority, the LGMP lays the ground work for success in all three areas."
