The City of Mississauga has posted new noise warning signs in some residential areas.

The purpose of these aircraft noise warning signs is to ensure that home owners and prospective home purchasers within the affected area are aware that they are exposed to higher noise levels due to aircraft using the Lester B. Pearson International Airport. Noise from aircraft will continue to exist, potentially interfering with normal activities, particularly outdoors, of residents living in this area. Prospective purchasers are advised to carefully consider whether the level of aircraft noise is acceptable to them keeping in mind the future changes to Airport operations may change or increase aircraft noise.
