



Secondary or Middle School Class Groups: Assignment Launcher @*your library*

Bring your class group to the library to launch your research project, essay or assignment! Explore library resources in the context of your assignment. This 40 minute librarian led workshop will be followed by a **Library Tour**.

- Get the research process started with a discussion of the best research resources for your assignment or topic.
- Explore how to access and choose research resources, including primary and secondary resources.
- Overview of the library online databases and other online resources of academic quality.
- Live-to-web demonstrations and instruction on use of the library catalogue and online resources with sample searches on student research topics.
- Evaluation of information in terms of quality: purpose, objectivity, authority, currency, coverage and accuracy.
- Plagiarism and citation will be discussed.
- Delivered at Mississauga Central Library, in-school or your local library.
- Students are invited to work in the library on their assignments after the Library Tour.
- Library cards can be arranged prior to class group visit.
