BY-LAW NUMBER 0044-2010

**A by-law to authorize the expropriation of land  
and property rights**

**WHEREAS** The Corporation of the City of Mississauga is in the process of completing a bus rapid transit project (the "BRT Project"), comprising of a dedicated east-west bus transit corridor across Mississauga and running along Highway #403;

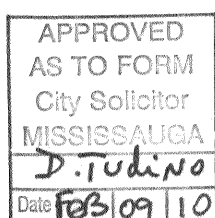
**AND WHEREAS** the BRT Project is a cooperative effort between the City of Mississauga, GO Transit, the Province of Ontario and the Federal government;

**AND WHEREAS** the BRT Project will establish a connection between local bus service, inter-regional transit and the Toronto Transit Commission subway, linking together high density development and employment centers across Mississauga;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacts as follows:

1. That the City of Mississauga is hereby authorized, as the expropriating authority, to initiate expropriation proceedings to expropriate all the necessary lands and property rights required for the City of Mississauga's BRT Project, including the authorization to prepare and submit all forms, documents and applications required by the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O., 1990, c.E.26, as amended, in order to carry out the expropriation of the required lands and property rights, including but not limited to an Application for Approval to Expropriate Land, to serve and publish a Notice of Application for Approval to Expropriate Land, to forward to the Chief Inquiry Officer any requests for hearings that are received and, in the event of a Hearing of Necessity, to report the Inquiry Officer's recommendations to Council for its consideration.
2. That the Commissioner of Transportation & Works and the City Clerk are hereby authorized, on behalf of the City of Mississauga, to execute, serve and publish all notices, applications, advertisements and all other forms and documents required by the *Expropriations Act* in order to carry out the expropriation of the lands and property rights required to complete the BRT Project.
