



CITY OF MISSISSAUGA NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study and Preliminary Design for Burnhamthorpe Road East from Arista Way to Dixie Road

THE STUDY:

The City of Mississauga has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study 'Schedule C' including preliminary design for Burnhamthorpe Road East from Arista Way (just east of Hurontario Street) to Dixie Road. The Study will determine future transportation needs to accommodate anticipated residential growth in the City Centre and future employment development around the Lester B. Pearson Airport (north of Burnhamthorpe Road East) and in the South Dixie Road area (south of Burnhamthorpe Road East).

THE PROCESS:

The Study is being carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for 'Schedule C' projects as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association "*Municipal Class Environmental Assessment*," (October 2000, as amended in 2007), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION:

Public consultation is a key component of this Study. The project team will meet with the public at key stages in the project to present the project, review Alternative Solutions and Design Options, and receive public and agency input. We want to ensure that anyone with an interest in this Study has the opportunity to get involved and provide input before any decisions are made on a preferred solution or design concept.



The first Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on May 14, 2008, which provided technical agencies, stakeholders, and the general public with the opportunity to meet the Project Team, review the study scope, provide comments on the initial findings of the study and discuss project issues / concerns.

A second PIC has been scheduled to present the alternative solutions being considered in the study, the evaluation of the alternative solutions and the preliminary preferred alternative solution. The second PIC is scheduled as follows:

Following the second PIC, the preferred alternative solution will be reviewed and confirmed or modified based on the consideration of the comments received. Representatives from the City will be present at the PIC to answer questions and discuss the next steps in the Study. A third PIC is tentatively scheduled in late fall to present alternative designs based on the preferred alternative solution and will be advertised in the *Mississauga News*, announcing the specific dates and locations.
