**ADULT SPORT LEAGUES
ARENA RENTAL GUIDELINES**

The City of Mississauga has a council approved policy addressing zero tolerance towards vandalism and violence including inappropriate behaviour at sporting events on city property. This is to promote a safe and positive environment for all participants and spectators. The following guidelines have been developed as part of the codes of conduct.

1. Adult Sport Leagues must accept full responsibility for their players, coaches and spectators while on City Property. Each League must have a disciplinary policy and procedure in place (copy provided to Facility Manager or designate).
2. Adult Sport Leagues must complete the contact person information form and return to Facility Manager at the specific facility they have rented prior to the start of the contract.
3. Adult Sport League players, coaches and spectators will adhere to the City of Mississauga approved codes of conduct.
4. City of Mississauga Facilities including dressing rooms are smoke free and all teams must adhere to Region of Peel By-Law # 14-2003
5. L.C.B.O. regulations prohibit consumption of alcohol inside facility dressing rooms, hallway areas, on parking lot property and outdoor sports fields. These regulations must be adhered to. The only exception is in specifically licenced areas.

ENFORCEMENT:

Recreation & Parks Division will provide full support to Sport Leagues managing their Disciplinary Policy and action taken against individuals in violation to above guidelines. Sport Leagues that do not control the actions of their members will receive a letter of warning from Community Services Department. Failure of the league to immediately resolve any issues will result in immediate termination/cancellation of arena rental contract.
