

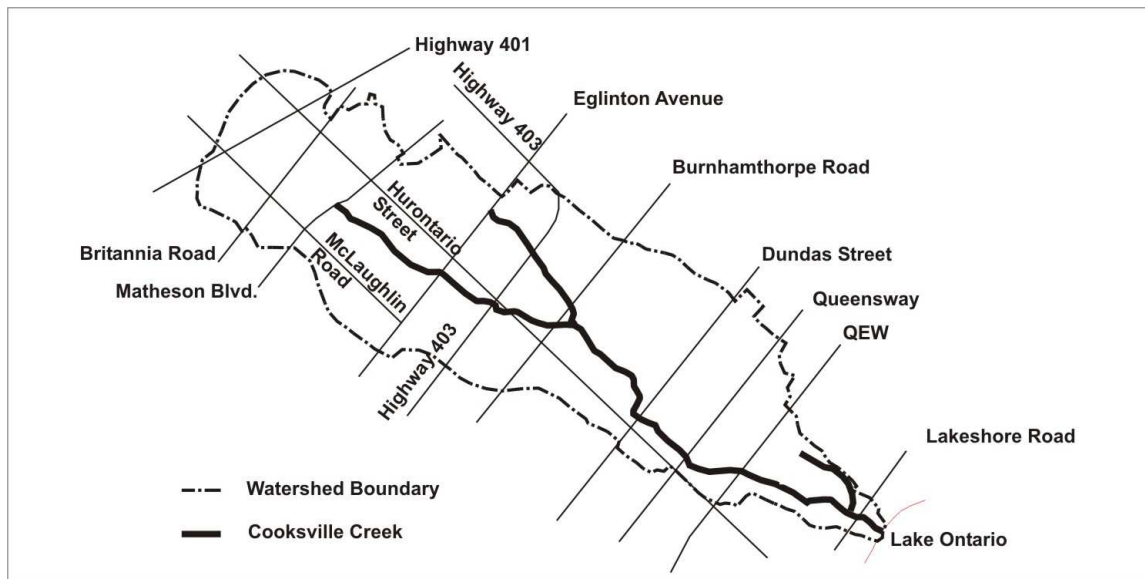
## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING COOKSVILLE CREEK FLOODING ISSUES – AUGUST STORMS

**Meeting Date:** November 9, 2009

**Time:** 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

**Meeting Place:** Mississauga Civic Centre, Council Chamber, 300 City Centre Drive

The rainfall events in August, in particular on August 4<sup>th</sup>, generated a large number of flooding related complaints to the City and Region of Peel from residents living within the Cooksville Creek watershed. This is as a consequence of an intense rainfall event centred on or close to the Mississauga Valley Community Centre which caused flooding and associated damages to private properties, municipal infrastructure and infrastructure under other jurisdictions.



The City of Mississauga, jointly with the Region of Peel and Credit Valley Conservation would like to invite you to a public information meeting regarding the storm events of August 2009 and the impact of these rainfall events on the Cooksville Creek and residences within its watershed.

The purpose of this meeting is for staff to present an overview of the August storm events and subsequent investigations which have been undertaken including potential measures to address future flooding, for interested individuals to ask questions and express their views and for community input to assist with evaluating future steps.
