# MATTERS CONSIDERED:

# 1. Residential Rental Accommodation Licensing By-law

Corporate Report dated March 25, 2010 from the Commissioner of Transportation and Works with respect to Residential Rental Accommodation as Lodging Houses.

Members of Committee expressed concern with the draft by-law as owner occupied homes or family members paying remuneration would not be exempt from the by-law. Councillor Mahoney suggested that the matter be referred to staff for further amendments to the draft by-law.

# 2. Secure Bike Parking Project

- 2. That the Ontario Transportation Demand Management Municipal Grant Reserve Fund (Account 35190) be established for monies received under the Ontario Transportation Demand Management Municipal Grant program;
- 3. That funding of \$35,000 be allocated to the Bicycle Storage Facilities project (PN 10-234) from the Ontario Transportation Demand Management Municipal Grant Reserve Fund (Account 35190) as outlined in the report to General Committee dated March 25, 2010 from the Commissioner of Transportation and Works;
- 4. That all necessary by-laws be enacted.

- 2. That a by-law be enacted to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the Assignment of Municipal Funding Agreement for the Transfer of Federal Gas Tax Revenues under the New Deal for Cities and Communities, prepared to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor, with the Regional Municipality of Peel.
- 3. That Council grant authority to the Commissioner of Corporate Services and Treasurer, and the City Clerk to sign and affix the Corporate Seal to any forms required under this program.

- 4. That a by-law be enacted to amend the Purchasing By-law to give effect to the recommendations in the report of the Commissioner of Corporate Services & Treasurer entitled Purchasing By-law Inclusion of City Standards dated March 19, 2010.

# 10. Framework for a Public Art Policy
