MATTERS CONSIDERED:

1. <u>Access to and Acceptable Use of Information Technology Resources Policy and</u> <u>Supporting Guidelines</u>

Corporate Report dated May 17, 2010 from the Commissioner of Corporate Services & Treasurer proposing the Access to and Acceptable Use of Information Technology Resources Policy and Supporting Guidelines.

Recommendation:

 That the revised Corporate Policy and Procedure - Access to and Acceptable Use of Information Technology as provided in Appendix 1 of the report dated May 17, 2010 from the Commissioner of Corporate Services and Treasurer, be approved. That the existing Internet Access and Acceptable Use Policy (03-05-03), the Electronic Mail Policy (03-05-05, the Access to Information Technology Systems Policy (03-05-02), the Microcomputers Maintenance Policy (03-03-04), and the Microcomputers Security Policy (03-03-03) be deleted as they have all been consolidated into the proposed Access to and Acceptable Use of Information Technology Resources policy.

2. (Unfinished Business) - Cycling Route Trail Naming – Winston Churchill Boulevard to Mississauga Road & Glengarry Road to Dixie Road (Ward 1, 2, 7, 8)

Corporate Report dated April 12, 2010 from the Commissioner of Community Services proposing that the cycling route from Winston Churchill Boulevard to Mississauga Road be named Sheridan Trail and Glengarry Road to Dixie Road be named Queensway Trail.

This report was presented to General Committee at its meeting on April 21, 2010; the names were considered for at least thirty (30) days according to established protocol.

RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. That the name "Sheridan Trail" for the cycling route from Winston Churchill Boulevard to Mississauga Road, traversing through Ward 2 and Ward 8, be approved.
- 2. That the name "Queensway Trail" for the cycling route from Glengarry Road to Dixie Road, traversing through Ward 7 and Ward 1, be approved.
