MATTERS CONSIDERED:

1. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting

Kevin Arjoon, Legislative Coordinator pointed out an amendment to the minutes from the previous meeting. He noted that during the deputation on the Britannia Farm site, Mr. Tovey had expressed concern with respect to the pending agreement between the lessee and the Board. Mr. Arjoon noted that Mr. Tovey's concerns, as well as the Board's response would be reflected in the minutes

Mr. Rick Mateljan moved approval of the minutes of the Heritage Advisory Committee meeting held on April 28, 2009 as amended. This motion was voted on and carried.

2. Request to Demolish a Heritage Listed Property 1590 Glenburnie Road (Ward 1)

Corporate Report dated May 15, 2009 from the Commissioner of Community Services with respect to a request to demolish a Heritage Listed Property located at 1590 Glenburnie Road in Ward 1.

RECOMMENDATION

That the property at 1590 Glenburnie Road, which is listed on the City's Heritage Register, is not worthy of heritage designation and, consequently, that the owner's request to demolish the structure proceed through the applicable process.

Rick Mateljan commented on the existing home and acknowledged that although it would be difficult to designate, the loss of the home is a loss to the cultural landscape. Mr.

Mateljan commented on the changing character of the Mineola Cultural Landscape.

Discussion occurred about the possibility of doing a presentation to Council to provide an update on the changes occurring in the Mineola Cultural Landscape. Mr. Wilkinson acknowledged that the house is one of the better housing examples of the Mineola Cultural Landscape. Mr. Wilkinson advised that during the summer months the Heritage Designation Subcommittee will be conducting a survey of the homes in the Mineola Cultural Landscape.

Mr. Craig Lawrence moved the following motion. This motion was voted on and carried.

3. Request to Demolish a Heritage Listed Property 975 Whittier Crescent (Ward 2)

Corporate Report dated May 15, 2009 from the Commissioner of Community Services with respect to a request to demolish a Heritage Listed Property located at 975 Whittier Crescent in Ward 2.

RECOMMENDATION

That the property at 975 Whittier Crescent, which is listed on the City's Heritage Register, is not worthy of heritage designation and, consequently, that the owner's request to demolish the structure proceed through the applicable process.

Bernie Hu expressed concern with respect to the recommendation of the Corporate Report and the attached Heritage Impact Statement (HIS) submitted. Members of Committee expressed support for Mr. Hu's comments and suggested that at the Heritage Impact

Statement should include a land title search for the property. In response, Mark Warrack, Senior Heritage Coordinator pointed out that the Heritage Impact Statement meets the minimum requirements of the HIS terms of reference. Discussion occurred about the minimum requirements for Heritage Impact statements and what was presented to Committee. Craig Lawrence suggested that a Committee representative could appear before Council to advocate the importance of Heritage Impact Statements. Councillor George Carlson suggested that a by-law be drafted, similar to the sign by-law that would require the submission of a complete Heritage Impact Statement and suggested that it become part of the planning process. The following motions were moved by Mr. Jim Tovey, they were voted on and carried.
