FILM: THE MYSTERY OF MAZO DE LA ROCHE

In 1927, Mazo De La Roche received international recognition as the recipient of the prestigious Atlantic Monthly Magazine prize for her book, Jalna, which was written while living in the Clarkson area of Mississauga. Mazo's professional and private lives along with that of her cousin, Caroline Clement are explored in this film through interviews with family, friends and fellow writers. The Mystery of Mazo de la Roche premiered at Hot Docs in Toronto in April 2012. Following the viewing there will be an informal Q & A with film director, Maya Gallus.

His prints are found in permanent collections across Canada and locally in the Art Gallery of Mississauga. Hunter will share highlights from his iconic career and photograph portfolios with the cafe audience.
