



## YIELD TO BUS

Since January 2004, the provincial Highway Traffic Act has made it mandatory for motorists to yield the right-of-way to buses re-entering traffic from a bus bay. This new law is intended to make it easier for buses to merge back into traffic and to help keep buses on schedule. Mississauga Transit now displays a Yield to Bus decal on the rear of each bus to remind motorists to

let the bus back in. Infractions carry fines.
