

Identification Requirements for a Library Card

When applying for a library card, an applicant will be asked to provide proof of identity and current address.

A valid **Ontario Driver's License** is acceptable as a single document.

Acceptable Identification

- Health card
- Citizenship card
- Passport
- PR card
- Birth Certificate
- SIN card
- Student ID card
- OAS (senior's card)
- Employer-issued photo ID card

Acceptable Proof of Address

- Any Benefit Statement issued by the Government of Canada
- Bank account statement
- Utility bill (telephone, hydro, water, gas, cable TV)
- Motor Vehicle Permit
- Mortgage, rental or lease agreement
- Property tax assessment or bill
- Insurance policy (property, auto, life)
- Employer record (pay stub or letter from employer)
- Secondary school, college or university report card or transcript
