### A Benares Historic House Online Virtual Tour

Stephanie Meeuwse, Museums Collections and Exhibit Coordinator and Wilson Santos, Web Designer, took the Committee through the Benares Historic House virtual tour launched on the Museums of Mississauga website (www.museumsofmississauga.com). This interactive tour provides a room-by-room virtual tour of the museum with stories, images, and artifacts from the Harris Family. It features information and descriptions of artifacts within the house as well as video and audio from Barbara Sayers Larson and Geoffrey Harris Sayers who once lived in the Benares. Committee discussed the ability to track the user traffic on the virtual tour and indicated that this would be useful information to measure public awareness of Benares.
