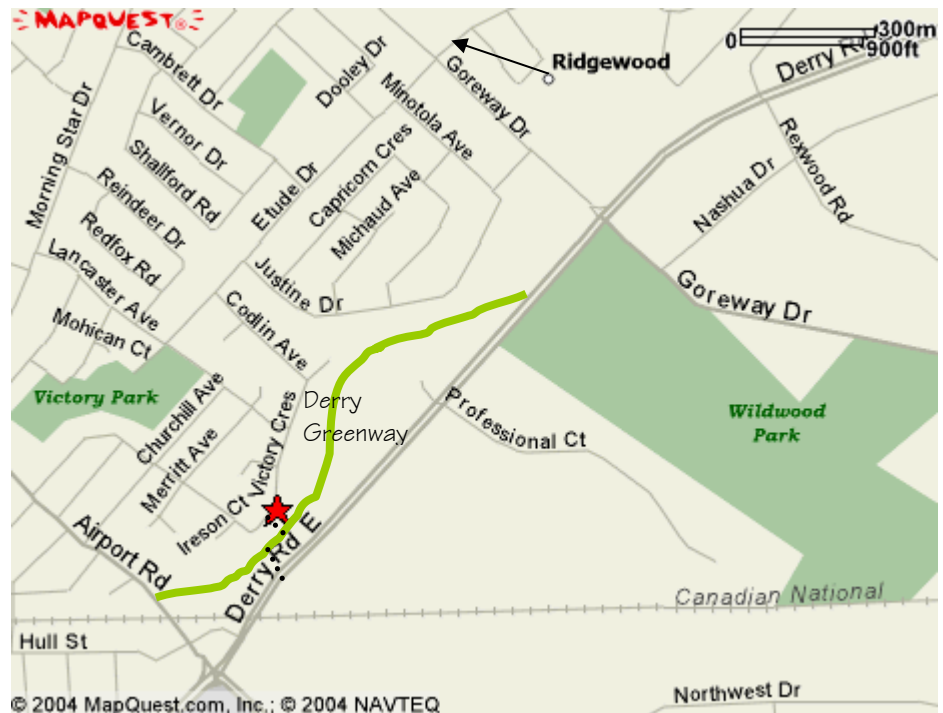
## Directions:

There are two access points to the Derry Greenway.

- One access is via a public path (dotted line) from Derry Road, just east of Airport Road. This option is good if you are traveling by public transit and do not need parking.
- The other access is via a public path (dotted line) from the inner South West corner of Victory Crescent. This option is better if you need parking space. Parking is available on Victory Crescent and nearby streets.

Some reserved parking will be available for invited officials.

The general public is not eligible to attend events at Ridgewood Public School, however media may attend. Parking is on neighbourhood streets.
