## Will your party commit to developing a new, long-term sustainable infrastructure investment plan to replace the Building Canada Plan when it expires in 2014?

Modern, efficient infrastructure is a driver of a productive economy and a high quality of life. A Liberal government would see municipalities as equal partners and would listen to municipalities, keep promises, and bring the two levels of government closer together.

Liberals believe the federal government should invest more in public transit to reduce commuting times, make communities more sustainable, create a better business investment climate, and improve the quality of life of Canadians.

One focus of the Liberal Party's Canadian Transportation and Infrastructure Strategy is on expanding local and regional transit, rapid transit, and commuter rail that helps reduce greenhouse gases by providing efficient alternatives to private vehicles.
