

What is the HURONTARIO LRT?

The Hurontario Light Rail Transit project is a 20-kilometre light rail transit (LRT) line that will run along Hurontario from Port Credit GO Station in Mississauga to the Gateway Terminal at Steeles in Brampton. Major construction will begin in 2018, with service starting in 2022.

Information as of July 08, 2016

Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Investigation along Hurontario Street

- Over the next several months, crews will begin conducting preparatory activities and utility works including surveying and locating utilities to obtain additional information on sub-surface utilities and ground conditions in various locations along Hurontario Street.

What Work is Taking Place?

- Crews will be conducting an SUE investigation along **Hurontario Street between Square One Drive and Elia Drive** to determine the location and depth of existing utilities.

Timing

- SUE investigation will begin as early as July 11, 2016, and be on-going until as late as July 29, 2016.
- SUE investigation will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances

What to Expect

- Crews of about 2 to 4 workers will be present in the vicinity of Square One Drive and Elia Drive along Hurontario Street.
- Crews will be using handheld geometric equipment.

Traffic Details

- While most of the work is contained within boulevards, intermittent lane reductions along Hurontario Street, between Square One Drive and Elia Drive will be required to access utilities within the roadway.
- Pedestrian and property access will be maintained.
- As always, please take care when travelling near work sites.
