Dear Resident:

Further to my letter and questionnaire of May 6, 2010 I wish to thank you for your responses and comments regarding the stop signs recently installed at the intersection of Paddock Crescent and Bridlepath Trail, and Bridepath Trail and Promontory Drive.

I have received a number of diverse responses and based on the responses to date I am organizing a community meeting to discuss and attempt to find solutions that best suit the community. Along with myself, in attendance at the meeting, will be staff from both the Transportation and Works Department, and Peel Regional Police.

I am also including a copy of the staff report which was referred to in my letter of May 6<sup>th</sup> wherein staff did not recommend stop signs, but due to the concerns and ongoing complaints from residents on Bridlepath Trail of cut-through traffic avoiding the intersection of Mississauga Road and Burnhamthorpe Road, and complaints of dangerous speeding and near miss collisions with pedestrians, the stop signs were installed to act as a deterrent to this behaviour, safety being the primary focus.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday June 9, 2010 from 7:00-9:00 pm at St. Mark Catholic Elementary School, 3675 Sawmill Valley Drive.

I look forward to meeting with you on June 9<sup>th</sup>.
