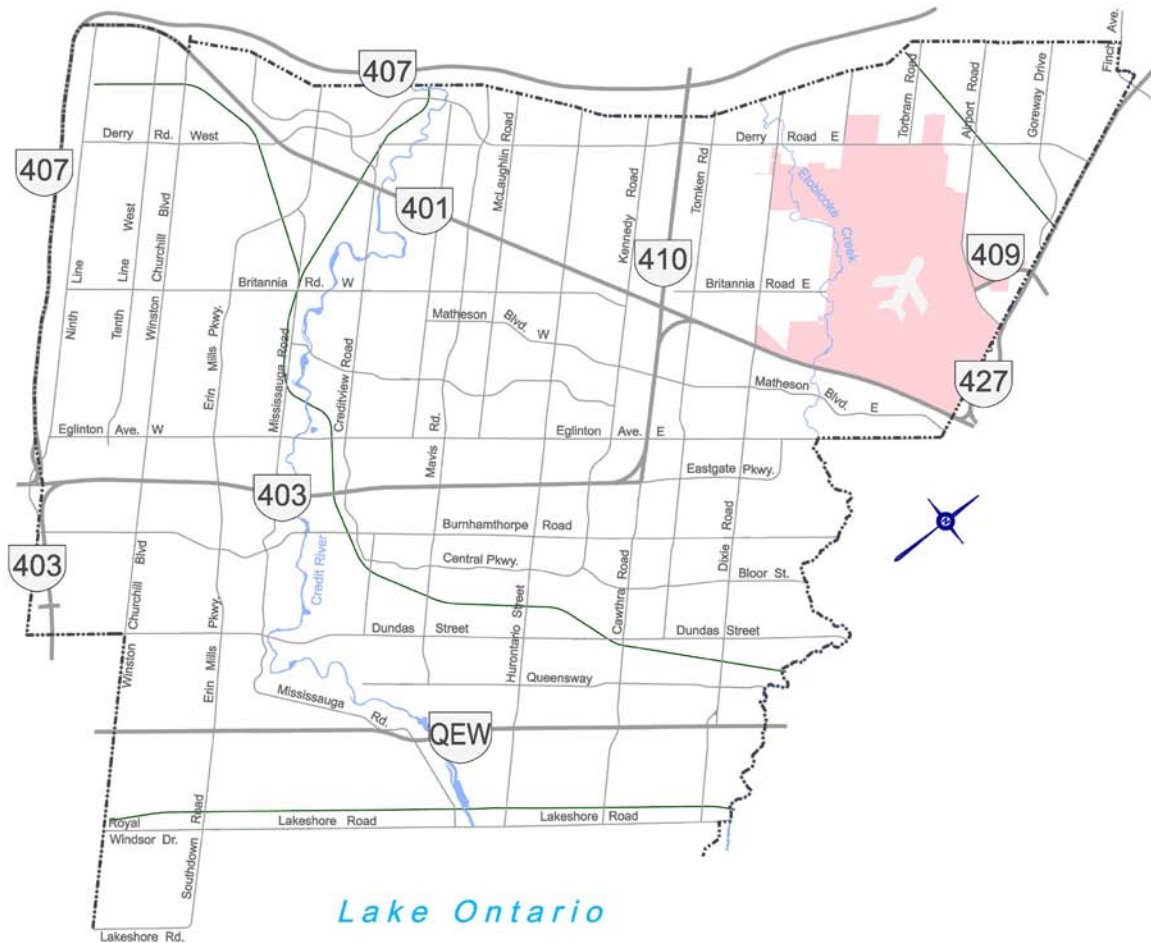

A MAJOR URBAN CENTRE

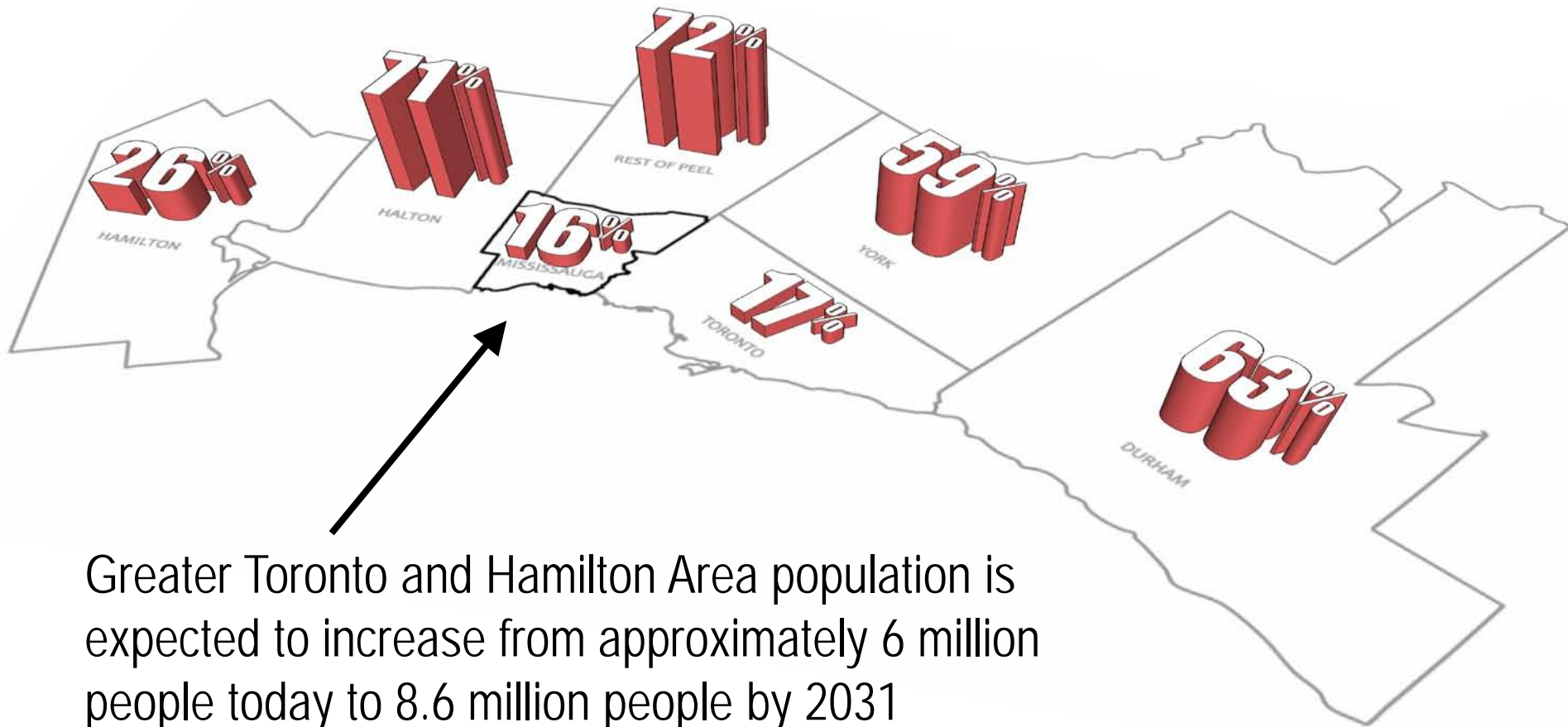
- 6th largest City in Canada

A GREAT NETWORK



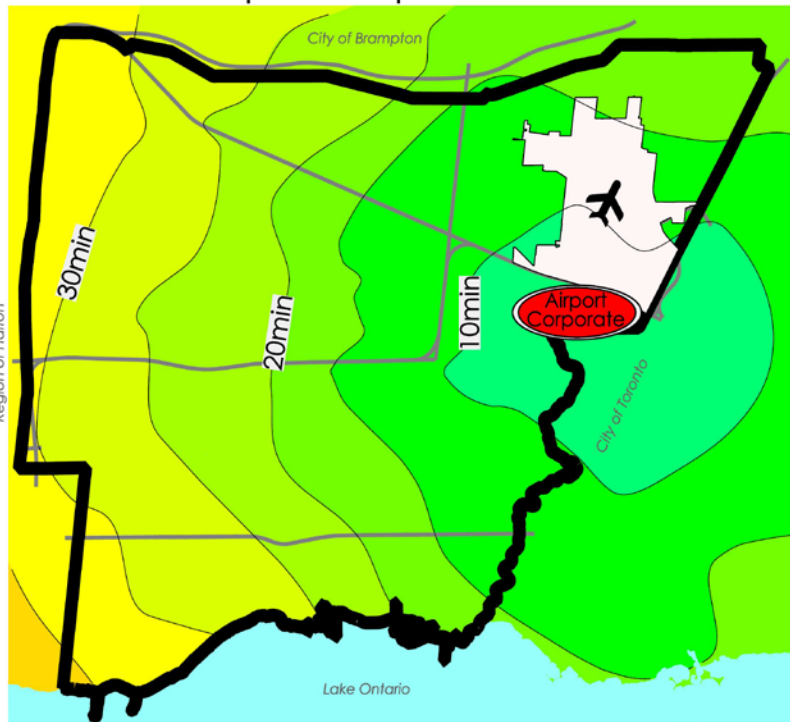
- An extensive road network

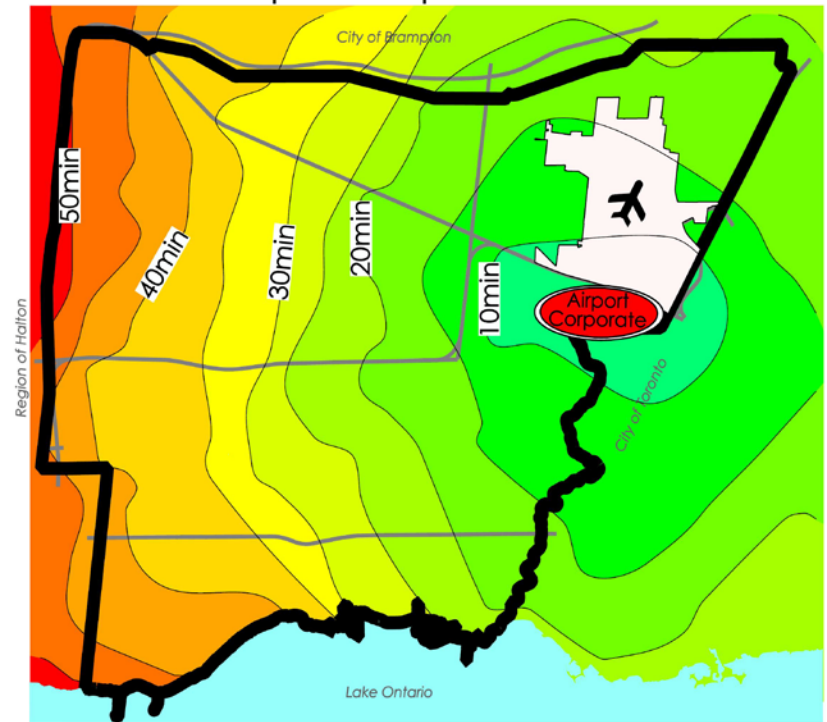

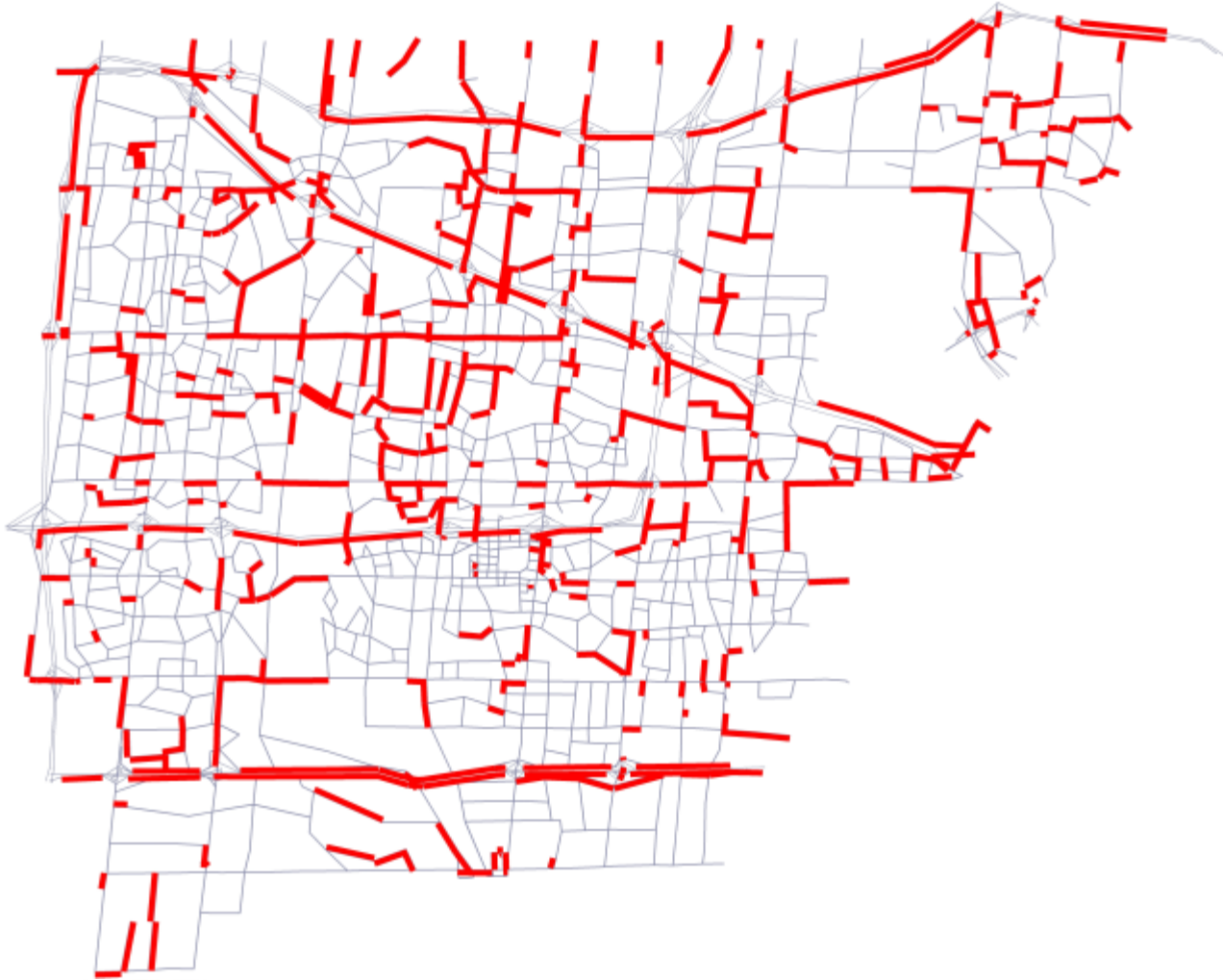
