David Brown, Chair, outlined the history of the new Loyola Catholic Secondary School site located at 4010 Sladeview Crescent. Boris Swedak, Citizen Member, outlined the confusion motorists were having with the driveway at the school and it was suggested that the driveway be reconfigured into a one way driveway. The benefits of this course of action were discussed by the committee.

Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor noted that the behaviour of the students, staff and motorists was very good at Loyola Catholic Secondary School. Councillor McFadden suggested that the staff, students and parents be congratulated for the efficient administration and execution of the arrival and dismissal times at Loyola Secondary School.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

The following recommendations emanated from the Public Information Subcommittee meeting held on October 5, 2012:

Discussion ensued with respect to the proposed changes to the School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) program. It was noted that Traffic Safety Council citizen members would be trained to conduct School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) inspections. The committee also discussed the School Walking Routes Program and it was noted that it was becoming increasingly difficult to launch and maintain the program due to the number of schools involved. - a. That Traffic Safety Council address issues related to the operation and maintenance of School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) programs at schools throughout the City of Mississauga upon request only.
- b. That requests for Traffic Safety Council to deal with concerns and issues related to the operation and maintenance of School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) programs be referred to the Site Inspection Subcommittee of Traffic Safety Council.

Mr. Brown outlined the history of the WildeWood Award for School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride Award) and the recommended changes to the award. 3. That the nomination forms for the WildeWood Award for School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride Award) be amended to reflect the changes to the award criteria.
