PRESENTATIONS/ DEPUTATIONS

Christina Herauf, Principal, Edenrose Public School, Nergish Khandke, Edenrose Public School Council, Danny Persaud, Edenrose Public School Council made a deputation with respect to the installation of road signs in the vicinity of Edenrose Public School.

David Brown, Chair, spoke to the role and goals of Traffic Safety Council with respect to traffic safety in school zones. Christina Herauf, Principal, Edenrose Public School outlined the traffic issues at Edenrose Public School. She requested that the Transportation and Works Department install a No Left Hand Turn sign prohibiting left hand turns during school arrival and dismissal times with the hope that the sign would help alleviate traffic congestion. Andy Bate, Supervisor, Traffic Operations noted that the effectiveness of a sign depends on enforcement and can create a false sense of security of pedestrians. Discussion ensued with respect to the possible installation of signage and the implementation of various solutions to help improve the traffic congestion at Edenrose Public School. Mr. Brown suggested that the issues of installing signs at Edenrose Public School should be investigated and noted that even with the installation of a No Left Hand Turn sign, driver behaviour modification would be necessary.

Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on November 3, 2011 to review the warrants for placing a Crossing Guard at the intersection of Artesian Drive and Fulwell Road for students attending Artesian Drive Public School, 3325 Artesian Drive.

Discussion ensued with respect to how schools could notify Traffic Safety Council when they had been requested to communicate with parents regarding traffic safety concerns. Councillor Frank Dale suggested that Traffic Safety Council could request that schools forward any communications they send to the Committee. Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor suggested that when Traffic Safety Council requests that communications be sent to parents, a Traffic Safety Times could be provided for the school's use. David Raakman, Vice – Chair noted that each school is unique and that a standard Traffic Safety Times may not sufficiently cover the communications Traffic Safety Council requests that schools send. He suggested that a letter from the Principal could be more efficient in some cases.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1. That the request for a Crossing Guard at the intersection of Artesian Drive and Fullwell Road, for students attending Artesian Drive Public School, 3325 Artesian Drive, be denied as the warrants have not been met.
- 2. That via the school newsletter the Principal be requested to direct parents to adhere to the following:
 - a. The No Stopping Zone on Fullwell Road.
 - b. Not to access the property via the school's driveway exit.
- 3. That the Legislative Coordinator be requested to send a PDF of a No Stopping Sign to the Principal.
- 4. That the Transportation and Works Department be requested to review the No Stopping signs at the curb cut and landing pad on the north side of Artesian Drive opposite Dundoon Drive.

4. Site Inspection Report - Queenston Drive Public School, Ward 6

Site Inspection Report for the inspection conducted on November 1, 2011 to review pedestrian safety at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Creditview Road/ Central Parkway West, and to review pedestrian safety along the walking route from the intersection to Queenston Drive Public School for students attending Queenston Drive Public School, 3520 Queenston Drive.

Rick Williams, Trustee, Ward 5, noted that a delegation had attended a Peel District School Board meeting with very serious concerns regarding the intersection and walking route. David Brown, Chair, outlined the findings from the Traffic Safety Council site inspection conducted on November 1, 2011, and noted that there are many people crossing at this intersection which increases safety for students crossing. Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor noted that the students crossing were in grades six and up and as per the City of Mississauga's policy regarding Traffic Safety in school zones, Crossing Guards cannot be placed for students in that age group. It was noted that the site inspection report would be sent to the School Board for information.

Discussion ensued with respect to construction in the area and Mr. Brown noted that the construction was on the opposite side of the street from where students were walking. Mr. Williams asked if students would be affected by an increased traffic volume once construction was completed at the Go Transit station as more vehicles would be accessing the station's parking lot. It was noted that traffic related to the Go Transit station would not be a concern as the traffic would dissipate prior to students leaving for school in the morning and would occur in the evening after students had arrived at home.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Site Inspection Report dated November 1, 2011, to review pedestrian safety at the intersection of Burnhamthorpe Road and Creditview Road/Central Parkway West, and to review pedestrian safety along the walking route from Burnhamthorpe Road and Creditview Road/Central Parkway West to Queenston Drive Public School, 3520 Queenston Drive, be received for information.

The School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) Report for St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School was added to the Agenda. David Raakman, Vice – Chair outlined the recommendation with respect to St. Joan of Arc Secondary School and discussion ensued with respect to the functioning of the School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride) at the school. David Brown, Chair suggested that Traffic Safety Council arrange for training for the staff at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School who are administering the School Zone Safety (Kiss and Ride).

Recommendation:

- 1. That the Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board be requested to do the following at St. Joan of Arc Secondary School:
 - a. Review the feasibility of changing the east driveway to an "Exit Only".
 - b. Review the feasibility of installing the appropriate signage to indicate that the east driveway is an "Exit Only".
 - c. Eliminate the two way traffic pavement markings and repaint the driveway with one way arrows to allow for one way traffic only along the east side of the building.
- 2. That once the driveway modifications are complete, the Principal of St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School, be requested to communicate to the school community including students, parents and staff that the east driveway is "Exit Only" in an effort to increase pedestrian safety at the school.

My name is virgil gazzola I live at in missisagua.my children and many others walk east along Caldwell and then south on gregwood to get to Tecumseh public school. the reason for the email is that the gregwood has no side walk. It has brought to my attention that there is no side walk because the residents on gregwood don't want it. There is serious safety concerns that are relevant on this route. The concern is that it is a matter of time before a child is hit by a car. To make matters worse building permits have been issued and there is consistently commercial vans and pickup trucks blocking the paved shoulder. I am asking for an immediate response as to why this (the parking of commercial vehicles) has been allowed. Also I need an immediate solution for protection of pedestrian traffic. I still don't understand how 10 household can trump the safety of a whole public school. You might be able to persuade me if it wasn't a direct route to a public school or if the public school was even a high school but it looks to me like some very nice political patronage, especially when every street in the immediate area has a side walk. I can't believe that I am even the first person to complain about this issue. I look forward to a response and an action plan that will improve the safety of the route.



1. Briarwood Public School

The principal has switched the bus drop-off area and the kiss and ride drop off areas. The Committee reviewed a site plan and made recommendations to current parking lot configuration to accommodate the bus circulation within the parking lot. David Marcotte will review the recommendations for implementation.

2. Applewood Secondary School

David Marcotte advised that the modifications have been completed.

3. Edenrose Public School

The Traffic Safety Council will follow up with the Community Services Department in respect to the construction of the portion of the pathway within the park to join to the school yard.

Further, the reconfiguration of the parking lot was discussed to improve the on-site traffic circulation and curb side drop-off for the Kiss and Ride. In addition the expansion of the parking was discussed and it was recommended that the area at the end of the parking be maintained for future expansion in anticipation of the increased school population.

In an attempt to modify parents driving habits, the members recommended that the westerly driveway be reconfigured to create a "pork chop" curb configuration to discourage / prohibit left hand turns into the school property. The Traffic Safety Council will follow-up with the Transportation and Works Department.

4. Edenrose Public School

David Marcotte was requested to review the feasibility of constructing a foot path to connect the playground with the park path at the rear of the school.

5. Ridgeway Public School

David Marcotte was requested to review the walkway along the park side of the driveway and the location of the walkway which intersects with the driveway directing students to cross mid driveway. There is no 'landing area' on the opposite side of the driveway to provide a safe pedestrian access along the driveway. It was recommended that a fence be erected which will direct pedestrians to the end of the driveway where they can safely gain access to the playground area.

6. John Fraser Secondary School

No update - David Marcotte advised that site works (painting and sign installation) will be undertaken as soon as the weather permits.

7. Willow Way Public School

No update - David Marcotte advised that site works (painting) will be undertaken as soon as the weather permits.

8. Munden Park Public School

David Marcotte advised that the City requirements are onerous and requested the assistance of the Traffic Safety Council.

9. <u>Vista Heights Public School</u>

David Marcotte advised that he is awaiting the modifications to the site plan prior to commencing the works. The revised plan will be brought to Traffic Safety Council for final sign-off.

Hillside Public School

David Marcotte requested that the Traffic Safety Council review this site as it is being considered as a possible expansion site.

11. Brian Fleming Public School

David Marcotte advised that site re-painting has been completed and he is arranging to have the modifications to the bus turning circle completed.

It was recommended that the northerly driveway be posted with 'Do Not Enter' and 'Buses Excepted' signs. Buses should be using the northerly driveway so as to eliminate the right turn into the bus drop off lane.

12. Willow Way Public School

No update - David Marcotte advised that site works (painting) will undertaken as soon as the weather permits.

The subcommittee discussed winter maintenance issues surrounding the shared City/School Board pathways to school yards from City parks.


