CALL TO ORDER

David Raakman, Vice-Chair called the meeting to order at approximately 5:01 p.m.

Peter Westbrook, Citizen Member requested that the following Site Inspection Reports be added to the Traffic Safety Council Agenda as items 14, 15 and 16:

-Item 14: Site Inspection Report dated September 9, 2011 for Burnhamthorpe Public School, 3465 Golden Orchard Drive, at the intersections of Golden Orchard Drive and Grand Forks, Golden Orchard Drive and Beechollow Crescent, Golden Orchard Drive and Grey Owl Point, Golden Orchard Drive and Lincove Terrace, and Golden Orchard Drive and Stonecreek Crescent.

-Item 15: Site Inspection Report, dated September 28, 2011 for St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School, 2480 Thorne Lodge Drive, at the intersection of Sheridan Park Drive and Fifth Line West.

PRESENTATIONS/ DEPUTATIONS

Ivana Matic, Resident, with respect to the walking route along Willowcreek Park, Sunnyhill Drive, Fieldgate Drive, and Havenwood Drive to St. Alfred Catholic School, 3341 Havenwood Drive, Ward 3.

Ms. Matic, a parent of a student attending St. Alfred Catholic School, appeared before the Traffic Safety Council with respect to concerns regarding a school walking route to St. Alfred Catholic School. Ms. Matic expressed concern with the walking route identified by Student Transportation of Peel Region and requested that due to the unique safety concerns in the area, bussing be reinstated. She also distributed a document outlining her concerns and those of other parents.

Rick Williams, Peel District School Board Trustee, Ward 5, was requested to outline the role of Trustees with respect to bussing. Mr. Williams spoke to the matter and indicated that the role of Trustees has been reduced due to a change in legislation. He also indicated that if Traffic Safety Council found the walking route to be unsafe, bussing could be re-instated.

Peter Westbrook, Citizen Member, spoke to the matter and noted that Traffic Safety Council had been requested to conduct a site inspection at the intersections of Havenwood Drive and Fieldgate Drive and Fieldgate Drive and Cardross Road. Discussion ensued with respect to the installation of crosswalks, and safety in City of Mississauga Parks.

Boris Swedak, Citizen Member noted that Traffic Safety Council could only address issues such as those related to infrastructure. He further noted that the Traffic Safety Council's Stakeholders Responsibilities Breakdown specifies that it is the responsibility of parents to ensure that students arrive safely to and from school.

Councillor Sue McFadden, Ward 10, suggested that Traffic Safety Council conduct an additional site inspection of the area with the Ward Councillor, parents, Trustees, and city staff from the Transportation and Works and Community Services Departments. Councillor Frank Dale, Ward 4, suggested that the Peel Regional Police also be involved. Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor indicated that Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) would be conducting a safety audit of Willowcreek Park and suggested that those individuals and city staff specified by Councillor McFadden could be invited to contribute to the audit.

Councillor McFadden, suggested that parents also work with Safe City Mississauga to establish a Neighbourhood Watch Program. Councillor McFadden also offered to speak to the Ward Councillor regarding the establishment of a Walking School Bus.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Legislative Coordinator be requested to invite the following parties to the Safety Assessment being conducted by Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design on October 13, 2011, with respect to the walking route through Willowcreek Park (Greenbelt) and in the area of Fieldgate Drive and Havenwood Drive for students attending St. Alfred Catholic School, 3341 Havenwood Drive and Brian W. Fleming Public School, 3255 Havenwood Drive:
 - a. The Ward Councillor
 - b. A representative from the Transportation and Works Department
 - c. A representative from Community Services
 - d. The Peel District School Board and Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board Trustees for Ward 3
 - e. Representatives from the Community
 - f. The School Principals
 - g. Representatives from Traffic Safety Council

That the matter with respect to the walking route through Willowcreek Park (Greenbelt) and in the area of Fieldgate Drive and Havenwood Drive to St. Alfred Catholic School, 3341 Havenwood Drive and Brian W.
