



TRUCK VISIT (FIRE TRUCK GOES TO YOUR LOCATION)



ONE HOUR MAXIMUM

- A Truck Visit must be booked 30 days prior to the request date
- Appropriate adult / child ratio shall be maintained to ensure adequate control and supervision.
- **Please Note:** The crew are on duty and will require a parking area that allows for a quick exit should they be called out on an emergency.
- Visitors shall obey the directions of the Fire Personnel in the event of a dispatch during the visitation period.
- Visitors are not permitted to handle equipment or mount any fire apparatus unless supervised by Fire Personnel.
- The crew will be provided with literature for the public.
