

Update on City's Actions Since November 9, 2009 Public Meeting

Cooksville Creek Task Force

- Formed in January, 2010 and chaired by Mayor McCallion
- Four meetings held to date

Watercourse and Creek Corridor Maintenance

- 2010 Capital Budget increased to address erosion needs worsened by August storms
- CVC and City have fast-tracked maintenance permitting and works along Cooksville Creek

3-1-1 Basement Flooding Script Improvements

- City and Region completed improvements to better handle flooding related calls

Debris Management Strategy

- Developed and implemented a new program to manage debris accumulations along Cooksville Creek and its valley woodlot areas

Cooksville Creek Flood Warning System

- City and Region have partnered with CVC to implement a real-time flood warning system at Central Parkway East crossing
- Will provide staff more time to react to situations

Basement Flooding Remediation Program

- Joint program, coordinated by the Region of Peel, initiated in late winter, 2010

Engineering Feasibility Study

- Currently preparing Terms of Reference for study to re-examine Cooksville Creek flooding remediation alternatives
