ROUTE AND SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR IMPROVED SERVICE

1 - Dundas / 1C - Dundas-Collegeway

Late evening frequencies have been revised with a service hour extension on Route 1C - Dundas-Collegeway, which provides service to UTM and South Common Centre. Combined service frequency improves to 22-23 minutes at stops along Dundas Street, between Mississauga Road and the Islington Subway Station.

5 - Dixie - Weekday &

The 12:37 am southbound trip from Cardiff Blvd. and Lorimar Dr., (STOP #5100) will now depart at 12:34 am to improve connections with Route 23-Lakeshore westbound at the Long Branch GO Station.

6 - Credit Woodlands - Weekday & NEW NAME The 11:45 pm eastbound trip from Westdale Mall (STOP #1106) will depart at 11:44 PM to improve connections with Route 19-Hurontario.

7 - Airport - Weekday

To better serve customers, the 8:38 pm southbound trip from Westwood Mall (STOP #2804) will now depart at 8:44 pm, and the 9:36 pm northbound trip from the City Centre Transit Terminal (STOP #0766) will now depart at 9:42 pm.

10 - Bristol-Britannia - Weekday

13 - Glen Erin - Weekday 🕹

Revised afternoon departure times for improved connections at the Clarkson GO Station. Service frequencies remain at 18 minutes during rush hours and 25 minutes during the midday.

18 - Northwest-Explorer - Weekday

22 - Finch - Weekday 💍

Based on seasonal customer demand during the summer, buses will depart stops every 18 minutes throughout the day.

EXPRESS SERVICE

101 - Dundas Express - Weekday 🔠

Two new westbound trips will depart Islington Subway Station (STOP #0804) at 6:06 pm to Laird Road/ Ridgeway Drive and at 7:30 pm to UTM, respectively.

The 2:43 pm and 3:21 pm eastbound short trips from Dundas Street and Mavis Road (STOP #0645) are cancelled.

107 - Malton Express - Weekday

New routing and schedule due to anticipated traffic delays resulting from Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project construction. All trips will now travel via Rathburn Road between the City Centre Transit Terminal and Tomken Road/Eastgate Parkway. Please check up-to-date schedules and route map online.

MORE TRANSIT SERVICE ON LAKESHORE ROAD

Mississauga's transit system – MiWay – is introducing improvements to its weekend service effective July 4, 2011.

Route 23-Lakeshore will provide more frequent service on weekends with buses departing stops every 19 minutes on Saturdays and 25 minutes on Sundays, to reduce wait time for customers.

Weekday service on Route 23 will also be more frequent with buses departing stops every 14-15 minutes during rush hours and every 19 minutes during the midday.

Other weekend service improvements include:

 Saturday service hours extended on Route 1C-Dundas-Collegeway; Routes 1 and 1C will provide an improved 23-minute combined service frequency at stops along Dundas Street, between Mississauga Road and the Islington Subway Station.

- More frequent Saturday and Sunday service on Route 61-Mavis based on a new route design.
 Route 61 will now travel between the City Centre Transit Terminal and Financial Drive.
- A new Route 91-Hillcrest will travel between the City Centre Transit Terminal and Mavis Road/Dundas Street on Saturdays and Sundays, with buses departing stops every 40 minutes.

Weekday service improvements, effective Monday, July 4, 2011, include a new route design and schedule for Route 109-Meadowvale Express to provide faster trip times between the Meadowvale Town Centre and the City Centre Transit Terminal while continuing to serve customers travelling to and from the Islington Subway Station.
