Service Changes September 6, 2011

ROUTE CHANGES IN MEADOWVALE 10 - Bristol-Britannia - Monday to Sunday Shortened routing will travel daily between the City Centre Transit Terminal and the Meadowvale Town Centre.

Route 10 will no longer service Copenhagen Loop or Meadowvale GO Station. Customers travelling beyond the Meadowvale Town Centre (to either Copenhagen Rd. or Meadowvale GO Station) can transfer onto the new Route 90-Terragar-Copenhagen Loop or Route 44 - Mississauga respectively.

45 - Winston Churchill / 45A - Winston Churchill-Financial - Monday to Sunday Shortened routing on Route 45 and 45A will travel between the Clarkson GO Station and the Meadowvale Town Centre.

Route 45/45A will no longer service the Terragar Blvd./Rosehurst Dr. Loop or Financial Drive. Customers travelling beyond the Meadowvale Town Centre (to either Terragar Blvd./Rosehurst Dr. Loop or Financial Drive) can transfer onto the new Route

90-Terragar-Copenhagen Loop or Route 42 - Derry respectively.

90 - Terragar-Copenhagen Loop Monday to Saturday A new local route providing Monday to Saturday service from the Copenhagen/Montevideo and Terragar/Rosehurst areas to Meadowvale Town Centre.

Due to a low ridership demand, Sunday service along the Copenhagen Loop has been cancelled.

MAJOR CHANGES TO ROUTE 19 - HURONTARIO Beginning September 6, 2011, Route 19-Hurontario will no longer travel to and from the Brampton Shoppers World Terminal.

This major change to the route will help reinforce service along Hurontario Street in Mississauga, between Britannia Road and the Port Credit GO Station where ridership demand is greatest.

and 19B-Hurontario-Cantay will continue to service the employment districts along Britannia Road and Cantay Road.

On Saturdays, a new Route 19C-Hurontario-Heartland will service the Heartland Centre providing customers with direct access to this major shopping district.

MORE EXPRESS SERVICE MORE OFTEN ON HURONTARIO STREET

Introducing more frequent service, extended service hours and additional weekend service in the Hurontario-Main Street corridor for customers travelling between Mississauga and Brampton.

MiWay and Brampton Transit are working together to launch two new Express services between Mississauga and Brampton to help grow ridership in support of a future light rail transit (LRT) system along the Hurontario-Main Street corridor.

The schedule and route map are available online. New on-street signage will be installed at bus stops along the route.

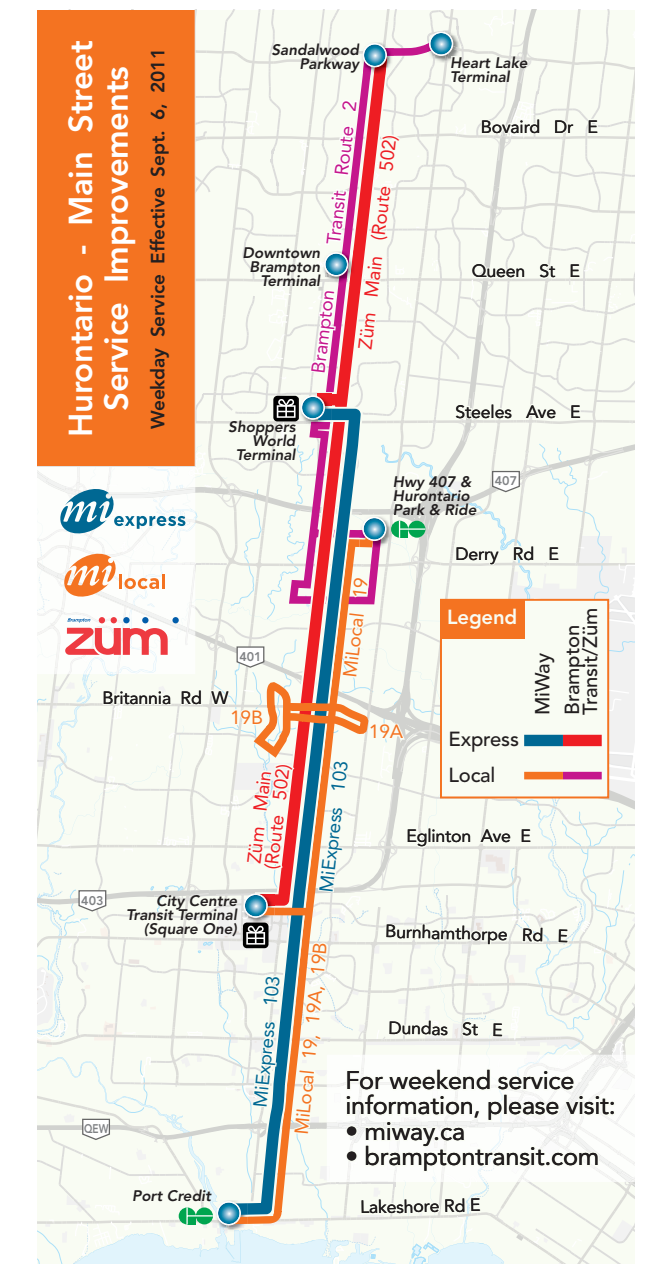
502 - Zum Main (Brampton Transit) Monday to Sunday Route 502-Zum Main will travel all day, seven days a week, between Sandalwood Parkway in Brampton and the City Centre Transit Terminal in Mississauga, via the Brampton Shoppers World Terminal.

SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR IMPROVED SERVICE Please check up-to-date departure times online

3 - Bloor - Weekday Midday service frequency improves - buses will now depart stops approximately every 16 minutes, rather than every 19 minutes.

4 - Sherway Gardens - Weekday The Huron Park Loop area, including Paisley Boulevard west of Mavis Road, will no longer be served by this route before 6:30 am and after 9:30 pm.

5 - Dixie - Weekday The 10:49 pm northbound trip from the Long Branch GO Station will now depart at 10:52 pm to improve connections with GO Trains.

15 - Drew - Weekday Departure times between Derry Road/Airport Road and Brandon Gate Drive have been revised on four short trips along this route.

15A - Drew-Brampton - Weekday The 6:08 am departure from Shoppers World (STOP #2610) will be replaced by a new 6:13 am eastbound departure from the Hurontario Street & Highway 407 GO Bus Park and Ride facility (STOP #2182).

22 - Finch - Weekday Regular service frequencies will be restored to serve more customers during the academic year.

29 - Park Royal - Weekday The 11:09 pm southbound trip from Clarkson GO

30 - Woodbine - Weekday The 12:00 pm westbound trip from Woodbine Centre (STOP #2923) will now depart at 11:58 am to arrive at Derry Road at Goreway Drive (STOP #2987) at 12:02 pm for improved connections with Route 42-Derry.

34 - Credit Valley - Sunday A new eastbound trip will depart from Erin Mills Town Centre (STOP #3402) at 10:27 pm.

44 - Mississauga Road - Weekday Weekday schedules have been revised in both directions for better connections to and from the Meadowvale Town Centre (STOP #2244) and the Meadowvale GO Station (STOP #1226).

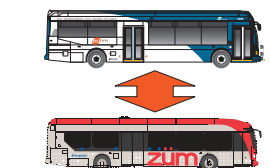

Transfers Policy Changes



Using Transfers: Ask for a transfer when you board the bus. A paper transfer expires two hours from the start time of the route. With a PRESTO card, the transfer expires two hours from when you tap onto a bus. Present your transfer to the driver each time you board a bus to confirm the transfer is still valid.

Conditions: Brampton Transit - effective September 6, 2011 MiWay will not reissue a transfer on any transfer. MiWay will not issue a transfer on any passes. Customers travelling between cities should consider purchasing a GTA Weekly Pass, Tickets or a PRESTO Card to get the best value.

MiWay Fare Integration with Brampton Transit / Zum: Effective September 6, 2011, Brampton Transit and MiWay will not accept each others' passes. Brampton Transit and MiWay will accept each others' transfers at any location, but only when there is time remaining on the transfer.

MiWay Fare Integration with Oakville Transit: Oakville Transit and MiWay will accept each others' passes, but only where the services connect (Clarkson GO Station and South Common Centre). Oakville Transit and MiWay will accept each others' transfers at any location, but only when there is time remaining on the transfer. Oakville Transit and MiWay will not issue transfers on each others' passes or transfers.

MiWay Fare Integration with Burlington Transit and Hamilton Street Railway: MiWay does not accept passes from Burlington Transit, Hamilton Street Railway or York Region Transit. Burlington Transit, Hamilton Street Railway and MiWay will accept each others' transfers at any location, but only when there is time remaining on the transfer. MiWay transfers are not accepted by York Region Transit.
