



**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MISSISSAUGA  
MIWAY, THE NEW MISSISSAUGA TRANSIT FARES**

**BY-LAW 284-11**

**WHEREAS** subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (“Municipal Act”) authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws with respect to bus passenger transportation systems;

**AND WHEREAS** Part XII of the Municipal Act authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees and charges for City services and activities and use of City property;

**AND WHEREAS** Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga wishes to repeal By-law No. 354-2010, as amended;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

1. In this By-law,
  - (a) **“City”** means The Corporation of the City of Mississauga;
  - (b) **“MiWay, the new Mississauga Transit”** means that division of the City responsible for the operation and control of the City’s public bus transportation system;
  - (c) **“Transfer”** means a voucher issued to a passenger after the payment of the applicable exact fare which will permit the passenger to use and be transported by a bus of another route without payment of an additional fare, subject to the conditions of use found on the reverse side of the voucher.
2. The fares and tolls to be charged for passengers’ use of the City’s public bus transportation system and the applicable effective dates shall be as set out in Schedule “A” to this By-law.
3. The fares and tolls as listed in Schedule “A” to this By-law are subject to Harmonized Sales Tax (H.S.T.) where applicable.
4. No discounts shall apply for early payment of any fare and toll set out in Schedule “A” to this By-law.
5. Payment for all fares and tolls is due at the time of purchase, unless otherwise posted by the City.
6. Any fare or toll shown as a “Cash Fare” in Schedule “A” to this By-law shall be paid in cash.
7. This By-law shall be known as the “MiWay, the new Mississauga Transit, Fares By-law”.

8. Should any part of this By-law be determined by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or of no force and effect, it is the stated intention of Council that such invalid part of the By-law shall be severable and that the remainder of this By-law shall continue to operate and to be in force and effect.
9. By-law No. 354-2010, as amended, is hereby repealed.

2012/2013 academic year commencing September 1, 2012, the UPass annual fee is \$141.70;  
and

2013/2014 academic year commencing September 1, 2013, the UPass annual fee is \$154.45.

\*\* The UPass replacement fee of \$20.00 shown in the chart above applies to the first replacement only of a particular student's UPass card during an academic year. The UPass replacement fee for the second and third replacement of the same student's UPass card during an academic year is \$40.00 and \$60.00 respectively.
