WHEREAS the City of Mississauga now is a mature and developed city of 680,000 residents and like other separated cities such as Hamilton, Ottawa and Windsor, Mississauga must be given the ability to govern itself as one City, to deliver municipal services from one level of government and to manage our future as a Separated City in a way that will benefit all citizens.

AND WHEREAS Mississauga needs to have one voice to speak out on issues that directly impact the lives of its citizens. Mississauga residents want to speak out and have a direct role on issues such as planning, social housing, public health and social services.

AND WHEREAS, as the sixth largest City in Canada (third largest City in Ontario), Mississauga is part of the Region of Peel where it has 62 per cent of the population but only 48 per cent of the vote on Regional Council. Mississauga residents deserve true representation by population to secure fair and democratic representation for its citizens.

AND WHEREAS, as a Separated City, Mississauga would eliminate overlap and be responsible for delivering one stop shopping for all municipal services to residents.
