



The Kiss & Ride program at Oscar Peterson continues to improve in its traffic flow and parent behaviour, though there are still challenges. I focused this inspection on the traffic flow along Tenth Line to the traffic signalled intersection at Perennial Drive. The implementation of a fence to restrict access to the east side of the building along Tenth Line has dramatically improved student safety at the school with less double-parking on Tenth Line where parents let their children exit while the vehicle is stopped in a live lane. Having said that, I did observe a few parents actually lifting their child over the fence rather than walking around to get to school property. The school principal has stationed herself at this location in order to curb the incidences of this action and to speak to parents when they do it. One of the issues is that the concrete walkway from the east side door extending to the sidewalk on Tenth Line remains intact, causing a visual invitation for pedestrians to use it despite the presence of the fence. The removal of this walkway has been recommended repeatedly and is again here.

Traffic congestion peaks at approximately five minutes before entry when vehicles and busses are trying to enter school property causing a backlog near — but not through — the signaled intersection. It only lasts for a few minutes and motorists are exhibiting more patience and better behaviour than in the past. The crossing guards are adding to the improvement of safety near this site.

The principal informed that the bigger issues related to traffic safety at this site occur at dismissal time.

It only lasts for a few minutes and motorists are exhibiting more patience and better behaviour than in the past. The crossing guards are adding to the improvement of safety near this site.

The principal informed that the bigger issues related to traffic safety at this site occur at dismissal time.

#### Recommendations:

- 1. That Parking Control be requested to enforce the parking restrictions in front of Oscar Peterson Public School, 5120 Perennial Drive, between 8:40 and 9:00 a.m.
- 2. That Peel Regional Police be requested to enforce the moving violations in front of Oscar Peterson Public School, 5120 Perennial Drive, between 8:40 and 9:00 a.m.

- 3. That Peel Regional Police be requested to enforce the moving violations in and around the intersection of Perennial Dr./Destination Dr. and Tenth Line to protect the pedestrians at Oscar Peterson Public School, 5120 Perennial Drive, between 8:40 and 9:00 a.m.
- 4. That the maintenance department of the Peel District School Board be requested to remove the concrete walkway that extends along the length of the east-west fence from the east side of the school building to the sidewalk along the west side of Tenth Line.
- 5. That the Dismissal sub-committee of Traffic Safety Council be requested to inspect this site.

This is a relatively new school site situated on a large parcel of land with adequate parking available. Many walkers were observed walking home and no conflicts were observed.

Staff assist with loading of students and monitoring dismissal procedures. Some traffic congestion was noted at the dual purpose entrance/ exit off of Thomas Street. The principal indicated because of this congestion, parents often drop off or pick up students on the City right of way. The Principal has already spoken to Peel District School Board to investigate altering the east driveway access to a one way "exit" only while retaining access off of Churchill Meadows Boulevard as a two way system serving the school, community centre and library.

It is my opinion that implementing this change would most certainly lessen traffic congestion on Thomas Street in the vicinity of St. Joan of Arc Secondary School.

Dismissal works at the school but would be improved with the noted recommendation.

#### Recommendation:

- 1. That Parking Enforcement be requested to enforce parking infractions along Thomas Street and Churchill Meadows Boulevard in the vicinity of Joan of Arc Secondary School, 3801 Thomas Street, between 2:20 p.m. and 2:40 p.m.
- 2. That the Peel District School board be requested to review the feasibility of doing the following at Joan of Arc Secondary School:
  - a. Making the east driveway from Thomas Street onto the school property an Exit Only driveway.
  - b. Paint appropriate pavement markings indicating that the east driveway is Exit Only.
  - c. Install Exit Only signs at the east driveway.
- 3. That once the Peel District School Board has completed the work on the Exit Only east driveway, the Principal of Joan of Arc Secondary School be requested to communicate to parents and students regarding the change to the driveway layout.
