David Brown, Chair, outlined the history of the new Loyola Catholic Secondary School site located at 4010 Sladeview Crescent. Boris Swedak, Citizen Member, outlined the confusion motorists were having with the driveway at the school and it was suggested that the driveway be reconfigured into a one way driveway. The benefits of this course of action were discussed by the committee.

Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor noted that the behaviour of the students, staff and motorists was very good at Loyola Catholic Secondary School. Councillor McFadden suggested that the staff, students and parents be congratulated for the efficient administration and execution of the arrival and dismissal times at Loyola Secondary School.







We have been having a HUGE issue at the corner of Dundas st w and Credit Woodlands in regards to south bound left turners.

The intersection leads south into our lovely Springfield Co-op and often cars travelling south on Credit Woodlands are turning either right (westbound) or left (eastbound). It is the southbound traffic that is turning to left to head eastbound that are causing an "issue".


My husband and I complained earlier in the school year and now there is anew crossing quard there that is also bring this issue up to her supervisors. Our eldest daughter was almost run over WITH a crossing guard crossing her!!! I am being told (by my 11 yr old daughter) that this same lady has done this repeatedly and that "they" went to her house and "talked to her" - not sure who "they" are (maybe she means the police?) but still something more PERMANENT needs to be done!!!!

There are a set of traffic lights located at Square One on the east side that allow pedestrians to cross BEFORE the vehicle traffic is given a signal to turn. The walk hand comes on while the vehicle light stays red then the hand flashes and stops and then vehicle traffic is allowed to go. This only happens if the pedestrian crossing button is pushed, so any other time it would not impede the flow of traffic. I am a school bus driver and I know the traffic laws. You are to only have ONE vehicle pulled out to the centre of the intersection to wait to turn. When they are sitting there, they are to NOT turn their wheels and begin turning until the intersection is clear (that includes pedestrians). This is NOT the case here. When these drivers pull out and then begin their turn they are RUSHING the pedestrians who are often CHILDREN and we all know that children can be unpredictable, so.... until the quard is back on the curb, these drivers should NOT even be starting their turn!! Also, it blocks any NORTH BOUND vehicles that may approach the intersection, from coming thru!! We have asked for police presence, but have been told that because there are TWO crossing quards there, THEY are our "traffic control" :o(

Last year, the children in this co-op were able to get busing, however, because the school board changed the "rules" NONE of the children here are able to catch a school bus to school :o(They are .9 kms from school and the distance is 1 km or more. BUT...... again, they have to cross a MAJOR intersection!!! at least 7 or 8 lanes wide!!!!!! I called your Mississauga office this morning and was advised to call Katie Mahoney City Counsellor. I am waiting for her to reutn my call now.

I have CC'ed both Ms. Mahoney, Traffic Safety Council coordinator and the STOPR contact.





Good day Laura, thanks for taking my call the other day.

My name is Mark Azzarello and I have two children that attend Saint Bernard of Clarivaux Catholic Elementary School. They are in grade one and grade four and are not eligible for busing. I had appealed this eligibility decision last year with STOPR and was never given a satisfactory response as my children were ultimately afforded courtesy seating. Because they received courtesy seats my inquiry did not receive a fulsome review. I am again in the same predicament this year, except that only one of my children were selected for the courtesy seating. The basis of my appeal is that incorrect measurement data is being used to determine the distance between my house and the school. The Geo Query system that is being used by STOPR to determine these distances states that my residence is 0.98 km from the school. I have physically measured this route and it is clearly over the 1 km eligibility threshold (property line to property line). They are supporting and standing firm on the distance that their system has provided, yet have acknowledged there is an inherent variance to the system's final calculations....this is very frustrating.

Furthermore, upon exploring the manner in which these distances are determined it became evident that this organization does not consult with the recommendations of the Traffic Safety Council regarding the safe walking route a child should be walking to school. In my children's case, they are being expected to cross Tenth Line during extremely busy times of the day without a crossing guard. There is a crossing guard in the area, but the guard is located three streets south of the school and primarily services two nearby public schools. The use of this existing safe crossing would add an additional 0.7 km to my children's walk to and from the school.

In an effort to provide my children with a safe walking route to their school, I would like to request that a crossing guard be assigned to the intersection at Escada Drive and Tenth Line.


In addition to this, as a concerned resident, I would be remiss if I didn't recommend that a review of the current practices be undertaken to ensure STOPR calculates distances that are in accordance with the Traffic Safety Council findings. The current manner in which this program is being delivered is not only irresponsible, but it also jeopardizes the ability of all interested parties in achieving their mandates related to the safety of the children in our communities. I ask that this be added to the agenda for the next meeting date of October 24th, 2012.

I would also like comments on additional signage at the school and school drop off area.






Hi Laura,

Hi George, did this issue ever get to the traffic safety council? I suggest that it be addressed. In my view the situation is an accident waiting to happen.

There must be at least 10-15 buses in the morning and at night. They line up down the street ... in the middle of the road... due to parents parking in the bus loading zone, and also the "legal parking" down Vista. There are daily parents leaving cars in the no stopping zone, while buses are trying to get to the drop off place in front of the school. Basically the front of the school is gridlock at times, with absolutely no supervision for traffic... except a one crossing guard. The kids and parents are dashing in front of oncoming traffic.

I do appreciate the indication that all French immersion schools have the same issue, however, just because they all have the same issue does not make the situation any more acceptable.

In regards to local residents, sometimes the wait is several minutes to get out of our driveways, due to parents parking and leaving cars in the no stopping zone and general gridlock.

I hope the issue is treated with some urgency, since in my view there is a high possibility of injury due to lack of adequate traffic safety control by both the city and school board.

My concern is with the roundabout at the intersection of Churchill Meadows and Rosanna Drive. The roundabout has a sign that says yield to traffic in the roundabout, but the pedestrian traffic has not been considered. For example, there are pedestrian walk lines on the road, however I have noticed that the cars are driving at high speeds through the roundabout. The roundabout blocks vision for both pedestrians and vehicle traffic, and on most occasions kids either have to stop to let the cars through or the cars end up slamming on their brakes because they just noticed the kids crossing the street.

In my opinion, it is just a matter of time, before an accident takes place. In the short-term a crossing guard at the intersection of Churchill Meadows & Rosanna drive during school hours would be very beneficial. I would appreciate your looking into this concern.

Comments:

- 1. School personnel was on duty by 7:45 am monitoring access to the school parking lot and the Kiss & Ride lanes.
- 2. At 8:05 am the lanes opened up the Kiss & Ride., bell rang at 8:10 am with school starting at 8:20 am
- 3. At 8:05 am there were 5 school staff monitoring the Kiss & Ride all wearing the correct vests.
- 4. Both the students and the cars dropping them off seemed very well behaved.
- 5. Close to arrival time traffic was quite backed up on Rivergrove and my sense was it was caused by a 4 way stop that was just south of the school.
- 6. When I talked to the principal she informed me that parents were angry that they could not access the Kiss and Ride until after 8:05 am. However some parents dropping their children off prior to this ban were using the wrong lanes (bus lane) and going fast in this area. As a result of the ban she had noticed parents dropping children off on the wrong side of the road which she feels is impacting children safety.
- 7. I observed 6 large buses and 7 small buses that drop students during this time period.

Recommendations:

- 1. That the gate which is located in the centre of the fence that runs across the front of the school be closed as soon as possible.
- 2. Once the gate is closed that the Kiss & Ride painting be extended to the south end of the school just before the exit driveway
- 3. Once that is done then the parents be informed that they are to drive the end of the Kiss & Ride before letting their children leave the car.
- 4. That a Dismissal Inspection be done as soon as possible.

As per our conversation, here are some key points/concerns about our K & R Program:

-parents are using the K & R program as early as 7:40a.m. and have been seen racing through the driveway (school entry bell is 8:10)

-there is a break in the fence in front of the school which students use when the area is not supervised (despite being told not to), and this is a concern since they cross the driveway and this is a safety concern due to the above point (I was given a recommendation from the City a couple of years ago, and have followed up with my Facilities Manager about having the gateway closed.)

-despite the signage in front of the school (No U Turns, No Stopping and No Parking), parents are doing all of these, which is another safety concern, since students are now crossing the street in front of the school, etc.

-for the safety of all students, I have kept the K & R prog. closed until the teaches are on duty: 8:05-8:20a.m.

We are directing students to use the pathways off of the River Grove sidewalk to safely enter school property. We are also highly encouraging students to walk to school if they live within walking distance (and most do).

Dismissal is staggered and commences at 3:30 p.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. No conflicts were observed during this inspection. There is a narrow two (2) way driveway on the north side of property which is the only access is to the rear lot. A Guard wearing a vest, hired by the school controls automobile movements in and out of the rear parking lot and he does an excellent job. There are only thirteen (13) parking spaces that can be utilized by parents; the other parking spaces are used by staff members. Students exit the school at the south west doors, walk down a protected concrete walk to the rear lot accompanied by an adult. The dismissal procedures are well managed and dismissal works well at Sherwood Heights Private School.

Recommendation: No recommendations emanated from this inspection and the addition of a Kiss and Ride is not practical due to property constraints.

The road cross section of Whitehorn Avenue is narrow permitting a three car passage, when the east curb is occupied with parked cars, the remaining road width allows for a single lane for north and southbound vehicles. The road x- section of Whitehorn Av is narrow permitting a 3 car passage, when the east curb

is occupied with parked cars, the remaining road width allows for single lane north and southbound vehicles.

Dismissal works relatively well at Whitehorn P.S. due to monitoring by school staff.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

1. Hazel McCallion Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that he has been requested to install a fence at the front of the school so as to prevent students from crossing the middle of the driveway.

The TSC members concurred that this is a desirable solution.

2. Janet McDougald Public School

There was a question as to how the Orano access was approved when the last plans reviewed at TSC showed a cul-de-sac and walkway with no driveway and no parking area. The TSC members will follow-up with the City Planning department.

Dave Marcotte is reviewing the feasibility of the installation of gates at the Orano driveway. It was noted that the afternoon traffic is not significant.

3. Darcel Public School

This school needs some review as there are no sidewalks provided on the property. The driveway configuration is such that there is little opportunity to install a Kiss and Ride driveway layout and there is not a proper sidewalk on the site. David Marcotte is going to review some options.

4. <u>Stephen Lewis Secondary School</u>

The principal has raised a concern with the traffic and the driveway configuration. The TSC recommended that the easterly access be restricted to ingress only and the westerly access be restricted to egress only.

It was noted that this was recommended when the site plan was reviewed.

David Marcotte will review this with the principal.

5. Dolphin Senior Public School

A concern with congestion in the bus drop-off and pick-up area is creating confusion on-site. It was recommended that the arrows be painted on the ground providing direction to motorists. Also, the nus loading area should be marked (painted) on the driveway.

6. Erin Mills Senior Public School

David Marcotte advised that the school will converting from a middle school to a Kindergarten to Grade 8 school. There will some additional traffic to the school and a possible need for additional parking.

The TSC members noted that there is little opportunity to get the bus loading off the street due the site configuration and the orientation of the school building on the property.

7. Camilla Senior Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that the requested site works have been completed.

8. Ridgewood Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that no progress has been made on this matter. It is currently in the City's hands in regards to the expansion of the parking area into the park.

The TSC members advised that the local Councillor needs to contacted.

9. Edenrose Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that the requested site works have been completed.

10. Briarwood Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that this project is currently on hold.

11. Plum Tree Park Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that the requested site works have been completed.

12. Kenollie Public School

Dave Marcotte advised that there is a new principal at the school. She questioned the lack of school signs in the area.

The TSC members will request the Transportation and Works Department to review the school zone signage in the area Kenollie Public School.

13. Ellengale Public School

TSC requested Mr. Marcotte to review this site and consider what improvements might bring this site up to a more current standard in respect to the Kiss and Ride program. The site currently has busses loading and unloading on the street.
