4. Collision Tow Rates and Additional Charges

Corporate Report dated March 12, 2010 from the Commissioner of Transportation and Works summarizing staff recommendations and Towing Industry Subcommittee (TIS) discussions from meetings in 2009 and January 2010 concerning collision tow rates.

RECOMMENDATION

1. That Section 2 of Schedule 3 of the Tow Truck Licensing By-law 521-04, be amended by increasing the collision tow rate for passenger vehicles or light duty vans or trucks from \$200 to \$230.
2. That the fees in Schedule 3 of the Tow Truck Licensing By-law 521-04, automatically increase and be rounded to the nearest dollar on the first day of January in each year, starting in 2011, by the percentage increase in the All Items Index of the Consumer Price Index (not seasonally adjusted) for the Toronto Census Metropolitan Area, published by Statistics Canada, during the twelve (12) month period ending on October 1 in the year immediately preceding the rate increase date, as found in all other licensing by-laws.
3. That Section 2 of Schedule 3 of the Tow Truck By-law 521-2004, be amended to allow for an additional rate of \$100 for winching inclusive of the first five (5) metres (16.40 feet) plus six dollars (\$6.00) for each metre of cable used for vehicles located off the roadway and a flat-rate of \$190 for repositioning a rolled over vehicle to a towing position.
