Cycle Toronto – Bike Month

Keagan Gartz, Cycle Toronto spoke to the upcoming 2013 Bike Month launching on May 27, 2013. She outlined the background of Cycle Toronto and the partnership with Smart Commute. Ms. Gartz noted the launch of Bike Month would occur on Bike to Work Day and would continue to promote cycling events until the end of June. She noted that the City of Mississauga would be receiving two safety cycling workshops.

2. Communications and Promotions Subcommittee

Krista Lethbridge, Citizen Member spoke to the Toronto Bike Show held on March 1-3, 2013. She noted positive feedback was received at the Bike Show and that the booth location was in a good spot. It was noted that next year’s booth should have lights.

3. Tour de Mississauga Subcommittee Update

Dorothy Tomiuk, Citizen Member provided an update regarding the 2013 Tour de Mississauga. She noted that the Tour routes are currently being worked on and that the ridership goal for 2013 is 2200 riders. She reminded members of the Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee to confirm last year's sponsors. Discussion ensued with respect to MiWay sponsoring the new 15km Family Ride.

4. Network and Technical Subcommittee

Donnie Morris, Citizen Member provided an update on the 2013 Ward Rides and noted that dates have been sent to Members of Council and that each start and finish location would be at an ice cream shop. Ms. Tomiuk suggested rebranding the name of Ward Rides to "Re" Ward Rides to promote local ice cream shops. He indicated that each committee member needs to commit to attending 2 Ward Rides. Mr. Morris also noted that the Network and Technical Subcommittee would also be working on the Ambassador Program and that Darrin Walter would provide a route construction update at a later meeting.

5. McLaughlin Road Assessment Letter

Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee (MCAC) members reviewed the draft letter prepared by Irwin Nayer regarding the McLaughlin Road Environmental Assessment and discussed their position on the subject matter. Members spoke to the design options outlined in the letter and voted their preference is on-road bike lanes on each side 1.8 metres in widths with mountable curbs providing separation from traffic lanes.

That the draft letter regarding the McLaughlin Road Environmental Assessment be received and amended to incorporate Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee preferred design considerations.
