# New Two Bag Standard for Garbage Collection



Starting Monday, Oct. 1, 2007, the Region of Peel is moving from a three bag to a two bag standard for garbage collection.

# Why is the Region introducing this program?

In April 2007, the Region introduced the Organics Recycling Program that can divert more than 30 per cent of household waste from disposal. Moving from a three bag to a two bag standard is intended to encourage you to maximize use of your green bin and recycling boxes. By taking some simple steps to properly sort your waste, you will help to preserve our natural resources and protect the environment.

# How does the program work?

Under the two bag standard, Peel households that receive curbside waste collection services may place a combined total of two of the following items at the curb each week for collection: garbage bags/containers or small bundles of wood.

Each additional garbage bag/container or small bundle of wood requires a Region of Peel garbage tag attached to it for collection. Garbage bags/containers or small bundles of wood over the two bag standard, without tags, will not be collected.

## Did you know?

The two bag standard does not apply to recyclable material (blue box, green bin and yard waste), large appliances, furniture and other large items.

# Blue box and green bin information:

- Green bins containing non-compostable plastics (e.g. plastic grocery bags) will no longer be collected after Oct. 1, 2007.
- Recyclable paper and container material should be placed in your blue box or a transparent (clear or tinted blue) plastic bag for collection.
- Plastic bags can be recycled. Place all plastic bags in one tied plastic bag and put it in your blue box.

## Frequently Asked Questions

## >> What are the height and weight restrictions for my waste containers?

Individual garbage bags/containers (including recycling boxes and green bins) and bundles of wood must not weigh more than 20 kg (44 lbs.). Containers must not exceed 125 L (30 gal.) in volume.



## >> How do I attach the garbage tags to my bags and containers?

Tie your garbage bag as you normally would with a twist tie or knot. Place the tag around the neck of the bag and stick the glued ends of the tag together. Do not use the tags in place of a twist tie. For containers, place the tag around the handle.

#### >> May I continue to use my old garbage tags?

Yes, the Region will continue to collect excess garbage containers that are tagged with the orange three bag standard tag.

## >> Don't my taxes pay for garbage collection already?

Yes, your taxes pay for garbage and recycling collection services. The \$1 tag fee is intended to provide an incentive to reduce your garbage and encourage you to recycle as much as possible in order to preserve natural resources and reduce the need for landfills.

## >> How will the program be enforced?

Waste collectors will place a sticker on untagged garbage containers in excess of two. The sticker informs the property owner that all waste containers must be removed from the curb by 8 p.m. on the day of collection. Property owners who do not remove their containers may be subject to a fine.

# Exemption Periods

Three times per year, during established Exemption Periods, you may place unlimited bags or containers of acceptable waste at the curb without tags.

#### Your next 2007 Exemption Period is:

• two weeks after Christmas - Dec. 31, 2007 to Jan. 11, 2008

#### Your 2008 Exemption Periods are:

- two weeks after Victoria Day May 20 to May 30
- two weeks after Labour Day Sept. 2 to Sept. 12
- two weeks after Christmas Dec. 29, 2008 to Jan. 9, 2009
