

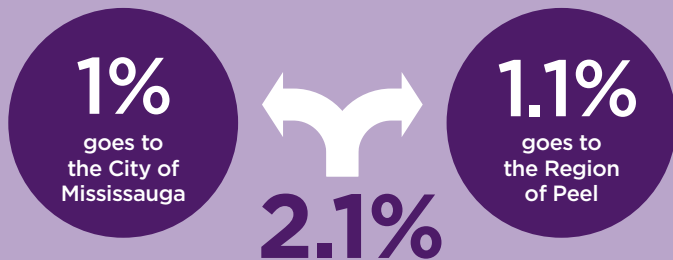
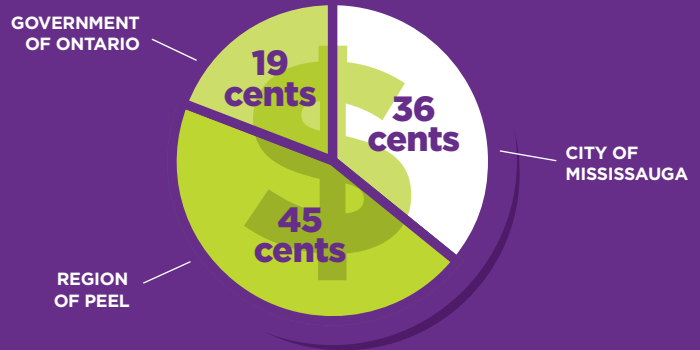
Mississauga's 2021 Budget Approved

The 2021 Budget allows the City to provide the important programs and services that residents and businesses rely on, while continuing to respond to the pandemic.

Budgeting for challenging times

In Mississauga, 36 cents of every dollar received from the City's portion of the tax bill goes to fund more than 200 services that residents and businesses rely on.

The rest is divided between the Region of Peel and the Government of Ontario.



For 2021, the overall residential property tax increase will be 2.1 per cent, of which 1 per cent goes to the City of Mississauga and 1.1 per cent goes to the Region of Peel.



Based on an average residential property in Mississauga valued at \$730,000.
