About the Study

Over the next 35 to 40 years the number of people who live, work, learn, and travel along Dundas Street is expected to increase. To manage this growth, the City is developing a Master Plan for Dundas Street. The plan will shape the future look and feel of Dundas, focusing on transit, land use, and public space, and will make recommendations on:

- A land use and urban design vision
- The appropriate mode, or modes, of transit
- Measures to mitigate flooding
- Improvements to the road, bicycle, and sidewalk network
- The addition of street furniture, public art and more

The development of the Master Plan is being conducted in compliance with Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process.
