Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study  
Sawmill Creek Erosion Control Project  
Folkway Drive to Erin Mills Parkway

### WHAT?

The City of Mississauga has been undertaking a Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for erosion control and restoration of Sawmill Creek from Folkway Drive to Erin Mills Parkway.



### WHY?

The City considers this section of Sawmill Creek as a high priority site in need of rehabilitation due to the presence of erosion and risk to infrastructure.

### HOW?

Over the last several months, the Study team has carried out various analyses to:

- Characterize the existing conditions of the site
- Complete assessments of the physical nature of the site, the hydrology, hydraulics and geomorphology of the channel, the ecological aspects, social elements and archaeological resources
- Development of alternative solutions to mitigate the impact of erosion and to provide enhancements

The Study findings and alternative solutions are being shared with the public through an Online PIC.
