CITY OF MISSISSAUGA – NOTICE OF ONLINE PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study: Sheridan Creek Erosion Control Project

(Lushes Avenue to Clarkson Road South)

Project Overview

The City of Mississauga (City) is undertaking a project to address the erosion impacts to Sheridan Creek from Lushes Avenue to Clarkson Road South (see map on right). Through the City's ongoing erosion monitoring program, it has been identified that this section of Sheridan Creek is in need of rehabilitation. Excessive erosion has led to bank and valley wall destruction; slumping of gabion banks; and elevated storm sewer outfalls.

Municipal Class EA Process

The Project is being carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule 'B' projects as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment", (October 2000, as



amended in 2015). Through the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) process, alternative solutions were developed and evaluated by the Project Team. A Preliminary Recommended Solution has been identified for public and agency review and comment. Subject to comments received, appropriate impact management measures will be developed for any potential impacts associated with the Preferred Solution. Following this, a Project File Report will be prepared documenting the MCEA process and will be made available for public and agency review.
