

DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

The Local Planning Appeal Tribunal amended the City of Mississauga's Development Charge rates on May 12, 2021. Settlement rates are in effect for building permits issued from July 13, 2019 until the current DC by-law 0096-2019 expires or is repealed.
