



FILING YOUR NOMINATION PAPER CHECKLIST – FILING ELECTRONICALLY

In order to complete your nomination, you must complete the items and steps on this checklist.

Complete: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Nomination Paper – Form 1 • Endorsement of Nomination – Form 2 (<i>not required for persons filing nominations for school board trustee</i>) • The Candidate Declaration • Access to Candidate Contact Information • City of Mississauga Sign By-law Acknowledgement • Primary Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses • Certificate of Permitted Amount of Contributions to a Candidate's Own Campaign – (Required only for Mayor and Ward Councillor candidates) • Filing Your Nomination Paper Checklist – Filing Electronically 	
Upload your completed forms through the City of Mississauga’s online appointment booking system	
Book an appointment through the online booking system for a virtual Nomination Appointment during which you will show an election official your identification proving your qualifying address	
At your virtual Nomination Appointment you must show an election official your identification proving your name and qualifying address. If you choose to use a name for the ballot other than the legal name that appears on your identification, you must bring proof that you otherwise go by that name. Proof may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Business Card • Bill 	
Following your virtual Nomination Appointment you will be sent a link through which you can submit your Nomination Fee (\$200 for candidates for Mayor, \$100 for candidates running for offices of municipal Councillor and Trustee)	
Once all of the above are completed, an election official will sign your nomination form as being received and you will receive confirmation that you are officially a candidate and can begin campaigning	
By checking this box and signing this form I, the candidate signed below, am requesting, in writing, a copy of the part of the voters’ list that contains the names of the electors who are entitled to vote for that office in which I am running in accordance with section 23 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.
