
Hub Vision

The Malton Youth Hub will be a safe, welcoming space for youth to socialize and access programs and services tailored to their needs



Hub Design

- **Commercial Kitchen** for teaching programs and food production
- **Music Recording Studio** with equipment and space to create and collaborate
- **Youth Dedicated Space** to hang out, meet and play
- Small and large **multi-purpose rooms** for programs, counselling, events and meetings
- Large, **open Atrium** with meeting and collaboration spaces



Hub Design

2nd Floor Layout

- Over 4000 sq.ft. of dedicated space for community agencies to offer programs/services catered towards youth



Lead Agency Update

The City of Mississauga will take the lead role in operating the Hub

Our partnership with Services and Housing In the Province (SHIP) has provided valuable information and insight into the Malton community over the last two years.

While SHIP will no longer be the lead agency, they will continue to strengthen the Malton Community with their strong community presence and partnerships with both the City of Mississauga and community partners.



Operating Model

The City will be responsible for the Hub management and operations including maintenance, cleaning of common spaces, facility booking and securing anchor and itinerant partners to offer programming

Leases

4-6 Anchor Partner spaces will be leased to non-for-profit agencies to offer programs & services aligned to the Malton Youth Hub vision

Rentals

Kitchen, Music Recording studio & Multi-purpose room will be available to rent evenings & weekends

Program Delivery Plan

4-6 Anchor Partners will be selected through a competitive process to deliver programs and services at no cost for youth (RFEI Spring 2022, Public Opening Q4 2023)

Benefits to Anchor Agencies Include:

- Dedicated office/programming space (500-1250 sqft)
- Shared operating expenses
- Easy access to youth/clients
- Opportunity to collaborate with other community providers
- Potential to expand existing services and reach

Terms Include:

- 5-10 year lease (\$16-\$18 sqft)
- Responsible for leasehold improvements
- Responsible for cleaning, maintenance and repairs of leased space

3rd Party Partners will be selected to offer programs in the kitchen, music studio, multi-purpose room, and youth dedicated room

Program Ideas

- Breakfast, Lunch and After-School Meal Programs
- Youth and Family Nutritional Programs
- Cooking Classes for Young Moms
- Homework Club
- Employment & Resume Building Workshops
- Creative & Visual Art Classes
- Music Programs
- Housing, Mental Health Support & Counselling
- Mentorship Programs & Opportunities
