

## 2022 Capital Works Planned Construction Projects

The following projects are planned for 2022 as part of the City of Mississauga's Roads and Stormwater Capital Programs:

- **Road Resurfacing**
  - Residential Road Resurfacing – approximately 55 streets amounting to 20.5 km
  - Major and Industrial Road Resurfacing – approximately 6 streets amounting to 6.9 km
  
- **Erosion Control Work along five creeks:**
  - Cooksville Creek (Kirwin Avenue, King Street, Camilla Road)
  - Etobicoke Creek (Ponytrail Drive to Bloor Street)
  - Carolyn Creek (adjacent to Barbertown Road)
  - Sawmill Creek (The Folkway to Erin Mills Parkway)
  - Sheridan Creek (Lushes Avenue to behind Fletchers Valley Crescent)
  
- Storm sewer improvements, replacement and slope stabilization on Britannia Road East
  
- Credit River Stabilization Project
  
- **Rehabilitation of five bridges and one culvert:**
  - Glen Erin Drive bridge over Lake Wabukayne Trail
  - Glen Erin Drive bridge over Hunter's Green / Maplewood Park Trail
  - Burnhamthorpe Road West bridge over Sawmill Valley Trail
  - Bloor Street bridge over Little Etobicoke Creek
  - Eglinton Avenue bridge over Little Etobicoke Creek
  - Orr Road culvert
  
- **Other Road Projects:**
  - Resurfacing of Matheson Boulevard East from Creekbank Road to east city limit, including the installation of cycle tracks from Creekbank Road to Commerce Boulevard, new streetlights and signals – approximately 3.2 km
  - Rehabilitation of The Collegeway from Winston Churchill Boulevard to Mississauga Road including the installation of cycle tracks from Winston Churchill Boulevard to the east leg of South Millway, new traffic signals and street lighting, noise wall replacement and utility relocation - approximately 3.6 km
  - Intersection Improvement Program – Two locations on Derry Road (Derry Road and Airport Road/Derry Road and Dixie Road), including transit priority measures
  
- **Other Work**
  - Construction of 1.6 km of new noise walls
  - Construction of 8.1 km of new sidewalks
  - Construction of 3.7 km of new multi-use trails and cycle tracks
  - Construction of retaining walls at Meadow Wood Road, Brookhurst Drive and Seagull Drive
  - Replacement of retaining walls along north side Dundas Street at two locations (West of Erindale Park Entrance and East of Robinson Street)
  - Torbram Road Sanitary Sewer Tunneling under Metrolinx Tracks
