









SPEED CUSHION DESIGN





- Raised area on a roadway that does not cover the entire width of the road
- Designed to accommodate wide wheel base of emergency vehicles (easy passage)
- Designed to discourage drivers from travelling at excessive speeds
- A series of speed cushions is more effective than a single installation
- Use on neighbourhood roads

Traffic Signal






Between Bloor Street and Flagship Drive



Existing All-Way Stop Location



Between Flagship Drive and Dodsworth Crescent/Corrigan Drive





Between Dodsworth Crescent/Corrigan Drive and Haines Road






