
Construction of Noise Attenuation Wall
On Ponytrail Drive from Rathburn Road East to Burnhamthorpe Road
(Rathburn Road and Ponytrail Drive Integrated Road Project)

Construction Work: On or after the end of November 2022 to June 2023

Scope of Work

The City of Mississauga will be constructing a new concrete noise attenuation wall along the rear or side of your property. Construction includes pruning of trees, removal of the existing fence, installation of temporary fence and the installation of the new concrete noise wall with all restoration work required. There is no direct costs to you, for the removal and replacement of the noise attenuation barrier. All work including the removal of the existing fence will be undertaken by the City contractor.

We ask residents to please remove any attachment such as vegetation, sheds, planters, or irrigation heads that are connected to the existing fence or within one (1) metre of the existing fence. If they are damaged, they will **not** be reinstalled or repaired by the City. The City accepts no responsibility for any damages to private fixtures placed on the existing wall or on City property.



What to Expect During Construction

Impacts	There will be some construction related dust, noise and traffic delays. The City will make every effort to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.		
Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.		
Traffic	Roads	Temporary daily lane closures may be needed for delivery of equipment and materials.	

	Sidewalks / Multi-Use Trail	Sidewalks/Multi-Use Trails in the vicinity of the construction area will be closed during the duration of construction.	
Trees	Pruning of City and private trees will be required.		
Parking	On-street parking in the vicinity of the construction area is prohibited at all times.		
Transit Service	Bus Stop #1534 – Northbound (NB) Ponytrail Drive at Lookout Court servicing route 20 will be impacted by construction. Arrangements to temporarily relocate this bus stop north of the existing bus stop location have been made with MiWay.		
Restoration Works	The construction site will be restored after construction has been completed. This work will occur once construction has been completed and will be dependent on weather.		
Utility Disruptions	Temporary disruptions to utilities (i.e. gas, hydro, water, telecommunications and cable TV) may be experienced. Every effort will be made to promptly restore service.		
Irrigation Heads/Sprinkler Lines	Irrigation heads, sprinkler lines and/or other private fixtures (including decorative fencing) that may interfere with these work located on City's property must be removed by residents and/or private property owners prior to construction. Irrigation heads and sprinkler lines and/or other fixtures will not be reinstalled by the City and the City accepts no responsibility for any damages to private fixtures placed on City property.		
Locates	This year the construction industry is experiencing significant delays in obtaining underground utility locations and supply chain disruptions. Material shortages have caused unforeseen delays to the commencement of construction. The City and Contractor are working together to ensure the construction dates noted above are met.		
Inclement Weather	Inclement weather may impact the installation of the noise walls at some locations. Construction sequencing may vary. Delays may be experienced.		

Future updates will be provided should there be changes to the project.
