

**CITY OF MISSISSAUGA – NOTICE OF COMPLETION
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study:
Sheridan Creek Erosion Control Project
(Lushes Avenue to Clarkson Road South)**

Project Background

The City of Mississauga (City) has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) study to address the erosion impacts to Sheridan Creek from Lushes Avenue to Clarkson Road South (see map on right) that were previously identified for rehabilitation. Excessive erosion has led to bank and valley wall destruction; slumping of gabion banks; and elevated storm sewer outfalls. This study was conducted in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association’s “Municipal Class Environmental Assessment”, (October 2000, as amended in 2015) planning and design process for Schedule ‘B’ projects.



Study Completion

The Project File Report (PFR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process for this Study. Based on the evaluation of design alternatives and in consideration of public and agency input, a preferred solution for each reach has been identified. The preferred solution involves reach scale works within the middle and downstream reaches of the Study Area (Reaches 2 and 3) and the ‘Do Nothing’ approach for the upstream reach (Reach 1).

Consultation is an important part of the MCEA process, and we want to hear from you. The PFR will be available for a 30-day comment period starting on January 25, 2023 and ending on February 23, 2023, on the City’s project website:
