ARTIST BIOS

Shannon Butcher

Shannon Butcher is an acclaimed Canadian singer, songwriter, arranger and record producer. She charms audiences with her joyful wit and warm energy - her performances capturing the unique spirit of each song while also celebrating the playful nature of jazz.

Born in Mississauga, Shannon is proud to be an established part of the Toronto jazz community both as a performer and educator. She has been in a fixture in major festivals in Ontario, toured across Canada, and performed across The United States and in England.

Shannon's original songs reveal the breadth of her influences, from the sounds of Big Band music halls to Yorkville folk coffee houses. As an arranger, she interprets chart topping pop songs with a fresh and exciting jazz perspective.

Shannon has released five albums under her own label Summer Bloom Records, her first album earning an iTunes' Best New Jazz Artist of the Year award. Her songs are in high rotation on CBC and JazzFM.91 and can be heard on radio stations across the world. In addition to her solo work, she is currently a member of the folk quartet Samways, which released its self-titled debut album in 2021.

Cat Bernardi

Cat Bernardi is a jazz vocalist, composer, arranger and music educator from Mississauga, Ontario. Her 'crystalline' voice and 'timeless' style have led her to stages all around Ontario, Quebec and into Europe.

Cat has performed in jazz festivals around the GTA, and was the 2019 TD Toronto Jazz Hotspot Feature in the Downtown Markham Music Festival.

Tracks from Cat's first EP Minor Ballad/Major Romance were featured on Jazz FM 91.1 and performed live for live audiences, upwards of 1,000 people. Cat released her EP 'Let's Get Cozy' in December 2020, supported by MAC's MicroGrant Award. The EP's title track was one of the Top 4 picks in Canadian Beats' "Weekly Beatdown" in the last week of December, and was featured on PopCan Radio's Top 24 picks for #NewMusicTuesday.

Cat studied Jazz Vocals and Theatre at Humber College and YorkU and continues to work with York University in a multitude of creative capacities.

Most recently, Cat was awarded a Microgrant from the Mississauga Arts Council that will support the recording and music video of her next single "Mona Lisa."

THEATRE POLICIES
