




TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES












SPEED CUSHIONS DESIGN



- Raised area on a roadway that does not cover the entire width of the road
- Designed to accommodate wide wheel base of emergency vehicles (easy passage)
- Designed to discourage drivers from travelling at excessive speeds
- A series of speed cushions is more effective than a single installation
- Use on neighborhood roads




FLEXIBLE BOLLARDS







King Street East



• Phase 1 (2023)

- traffic calming will be installed from Camilla Road to Cliff Road
- flexible bollards to be installed from Hurontario Street to Camilla Road
- Phase 2 (planned once watermain repair is completed by Region of Peel)
- flexible bollards to be replaced with speed cushions/raised crossing as per original plan
