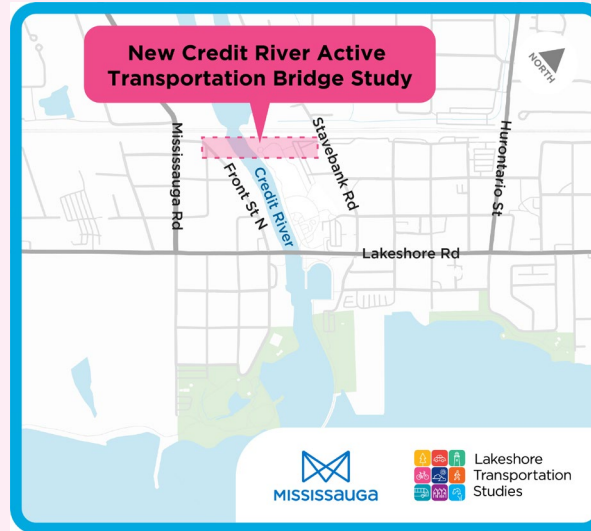
### The Project
